### Decision of ISU Disciplinary Commission

On January 12, 2017, the ISU Technical Committee Single & Pair Skating, represented by ISU Legal Advisor, Prof. Dr. Michael Geistlinger, filed a complaint against the Alleged Offender Mr. Sviatoslav Babenko, a member of the Figure Skating Federation of Russia and Figure Skating Official, for a violation of the duties of judges and of the Code of Ethics.

Following consideration of the alleged violation of the ISU Code of Ethics and of the Duties of Officials, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on March 11, 2017 taken the following decision:

#### *“Decision*

- 1. Mr. Sviatoslav Babenko has violated the duties of a judge and the ISU Code of Ethics.*
- 2. Mr. Sviatoslav Babenko is suspended in his function as International Referee and ISU Judge for Single and Pair Skating from January 13, 2017 (date of the provisional suspension) till June 30, 2017.*
- 3. All parties shall bear their own costs.*

The decision of the Disciplinary Commission is published in full on the ISU website.

This decision is subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), in accordance with Article 25 Paragraph 12 and Article 26 of the ISU Constitution 2016.
