ISU Centre Of Excellence Oberstdorf, Germany announces an initiative supported by the ISU Development Program: International Ice Dance Development Tryout for Skaters and Coaches on June 24-25, 2023 in the Eissportzentrum Oberstdorf, Roßbichlstraße 2, 87561 Oberstdorf, Germany.







### General

The aim of the Seminar is to develop the discipline of Ice Dance to all Skaters and Coaches who are willing to try and experience it in a new and fresh approach at a beginner level. Experienced high level international Coaches will moderate the Seminar and guide the beginners to the new discipline in the safest way. Daily off-ice including Ballett and specific Acrobatik and Athletics will be organized, as well as on ice classes.

The 2023 Excellence Ice Dance Tryout is in particular designed for Novice and Junioraged Skaters

## Focus of the Seminar

- Develop new knowledge in Ice Dance for young Skaters.
- Increase the skill sets of skaters who already skated Ice Dance at beginner level.

The number of Skaters and Coaches entered from each ISU Member is not limited but a general guideline has been established of a maximum of three boys and three girls per ISU Member (for a total of max 16 boys and 16 girls). If there are too many skaters entered, the CoE coordinators will reduce the number, using age and level as the criteria.

- The Seminar is also open to Coaches wishing to attend without Skaters.
- The Seminar will be conducted in English.
- Participants need to bring their general sports clothing with them.
- Coaches also should bring their skates with them.

Oberstdorf, located in the south of Germany, is easy to reach.

### By plane

## <u>Airport Munich – official airport</u>

Airport shuttle-train to Munich main station (follow the green signs to S1 or S8). The train needs 45 min. to reach Munich main station, where you need to change for train on platform 29 – 36 to the departure platform for Oberstdorf.

## By train

#### Munich Main Station - official train station

Nearly every hour a train is running from Munich to Oberstdorf. Most of them are "direct trains" without any necessary change. The time to calculate is app. 2 1/2 hours.

Other train connections are directly from the northern part of Germany to Oberstdorf via Ulm. The train ride leads you through the most beautiful area of southern Bavaria, stops in one of the oldest Roman settlements in Germany, Kempten, and brings you into Oberstdorf.

Train tickets are available at the Munich airport, Terminal 1, ground floor. The cheapest ticket is the so called "Bavarian ticket" for app. € 26,00 and covering 5 people.

#### By car

#### Munich to Oberstdorf

Motorway to Kempten either via Munich or Ulm.

Distances: Munich – Oberstdorf app. 180 km

Also easy to reach from Zürich (SUI) via St. Gallen, St. Margarethen, Bregenz.
