General Regulation

The 20th Merano Cup will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single and Pairs skating 2017, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

Place and date

The Merano Cup will be held in Merano at the Ice Rink Meranarena-Via Palade 74- Merano from 16th to 19th of November 2017.

Technical Data

All competition events and practice sessions will be held in Merano at the Ice Rink Meranarena. The Ice Rink (30mx60m) is indoor and heated.

Categories:

Senior ladies/men – Short and Free Program Junior ladies/men – Short and Free Program Advanced Novice Girls/Boys – Short and Free Program

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single Skating 2016 and all pertinent ISU Communications and ISU communication 2024 for Advanced Novice.

each National Association may entry up to two (2) competitors per category. The Italian Federation may entry up to six (6) competitors per Senior, Junior and twelve (12) for Advanced Novice category. After the deadline of entries, the organizing committee may decide if more than the allowed skaters could be accepted. Therefore substitute skaters should be nominated.

Entries are only accepted if payment confirmation is sent together with entries! The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

Expenses:

Travel, board and accommodation expenses have to be paid by the participants.

Panels of Judges:

Each Member entering the competitors is entitled to nominate one (1) Judge.

The panel of Judges will consist of five (5) Judges (at least with the qualification of international Judge). If should there be too many judges nominated for participation, the organizer reserves the right to draw for the composition of panels beforehand and inform those judges who are not drawn for service.

The organizer club will pay board and accommodation expenses for all Judges.

For all invited Referee, Technical Specialist, Assistant Technical Specialist, Technical Controller, Data and Replay Operator, the organizer will pay travel, board and accommodation as follows:

From Wednesday, November 15th, starting with dinner to Monday, November 20th, ending with breakfast.

Accomodation:

Participants, coaches and other Team members have to book accommodation individually.

The organizing Committee will book the hotels only for invited TS, TC, DRO, Referees and Judges at the Hotel Torre-Siegler im Thurm or Hotel Gruberhof just 5 minutes walking distance to the Meranarena ice rink.

Music and Planned Program Content Sheet:

All Competitors shall furnish at the accreditation the competition music of excellent quality on Audio CD format and all discs must show competitor's name, segment, nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time).

Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on one track and on a separate disc. In addition, competitors must provide a back-up disc for each program.

The "Program Content Sheet" must be returned with the entry forms to the Organizing Committee in time and it must be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Accreditation will take place at the Ice Rink Meranarena-Via Palade, 74- Merano:

Wednesday 15th from 02.00 p.m. to 05.00 p.m. Thursday and Friday from 08.00 a.m.to 05.00 p.m.

Judges and Technical Panel Meetings:

The initial Judges Meeting and Technical Panel Meeting will be held on Thursday 16th at 10.00 a.m. in the judges room at the ice rink

Draws:

The initial draws for the starting order of the Short Program will take place at the ice rink as follows: Wednesday 15.11.2017, 18:00: Novice Girls, Boys, Junior Ladies Friday 17.11.2017, 18:00: Junior Men, Senior Ladies, Men No draw after short programs. Starting order for free programs will be according the reverse of the results of short programs.
