Complete history list of Junior World Records

recognized by ISU as of **July 1st, 2009**

Compiled by Magne Teigen, WSSSA and Tron Espeli, ISU Speed Skating Technical Committee

In addition to a chronological listing of all results recognized as World Records by the ISU throughout the history of the International Skating Union, the list includes additional information on the circumstances of the results:

- * Type of skates used, distinguishing between "traditional" skates and "klap-skates".
- * Category of track, distinguishing between the following categories:
 - open-air ice rinks (out-door tracks) vs. covered ice rinks (in-door tracks)
 - Artificially frozen ice vs. naturally frozen ice
 - Altitude of the venue, distinguishing between 3 categories (high altitude, medium altitude, lowland).

This additional information is presented according to the following legend:

- * A result marked with * means that the result was achieved with the new kind of skate ("klap-skate") with moveable blades, which was introduced at the international level during the 1996/97 season, and quickly replaced the conventional speed skate design with fixed blades.
- * When the name of the venue (track) is preceded by i it indicates that the result has been achieved on a covered (indoor) speed skating track.
- * When the name of the venue is preceded by n - , it indicates that the result has been achieved on a speed skating track with naturally frozen ice. When no such indication is given, the result has been achieved on a speed skating track with artificially frozen ice.
