Reporting Harassment or Abuse

If you have experienced harassment or abuse or have witnessed someone else being harassed or abused during an ISU Event or other ISU activity, you can report it to:

- The designated ISU Ombudsperson for Harassment and Abuse, is currently Ms. Christine Cardis, ISU Anti-Doping Manager, who will also provide guidance to any individual regarding whether and how to report to the ISU observed or suspected harassment or abuse, in particular of an athlete;

Or, in line with the ISU Code of Ethics, you can report it to one of the following:

- The ISU Representative for the ISU Event;
- The ISU Event Coordinator;
- The Chair of the ISU Medical Commission;
- If a Skater is involved in the incident: any ISU Athletes Commission member.

Or, you can file a Statement of Complaint against the Alleged Offender in accordance with the ISU Disciplinary Rules of Procedure (currently ISU Communication No. 2001).
