

INTERNATIONAL-LEVEL SKATER DEFINITION

The following Skaters are considered to be **International-Level Skaters** to whom the specific provisions of the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures regarding Testing, TUEs, whereabouts information, results management and appeals apply:

- a. Any Skater who is part of the ISU Registered Testing Pool or ISU Testing Pool.
- b. Any Skater who participates in ISU Events, according to Rule 100/3, b) and c) of the ISU General Regulations.

ISU Events according to Rule 100/3, b) and c) of the ISU General Regulations currently organized are:

- ISU Championships
- ISU Grand Prix of Figure Skating Final and Series (ISU Grand Prix of Figure Skating)
- ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating Final and Series (ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating)
- ISU World Team Trophy in Figure Skating
- ISU Speed Skating World Cup Senior and Junior
- ISU Short Track Speed Skating World Cup

Comment

Any Skater who is/was ever an International-level skater according to the ISU definition will remain in this status throughout his skating career and for the 10 years following its termination.
