General

The goal of the seminar is to teach single skaters in the advanced novice and junior category, to work on jumping elements on and off the ice. Methodical exercises explained and shown by experienced international coaches will help to take home valuable tips and tricks. Daily training off the ice, including ballet and specific acrobatics and athletics, will be organized, as well as classes on the ice.

Focus of the seminar

Learning and improving methodical exercises that help learn and improve complex jumping techniques.

The number of skaters and coaches registered by each ISU member is not limited. If too many skaters register, the CoE coordinator will reduce the number of participants based on age and level.

- The seminar is also open to coaches who wish to participate without skaters.
- The seminar will be conducted in English.
- Participants must bring their general sports attire.
- Coaches should also bring their skates.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

Oberstdorf, located in the south of Germany, is easy to reach.

By plane

Airport Munich – official airport

Airport shuttle-train to Munich main station (follow the green signs to S1 or S8). The train needs 45 min. to reach Munich main station, where you need to change for train on platform 29 – 36 to the departure platform for Oberstdorf.

By train

Munich Main Station - official train station

Nearly every hour a train is running from Munich to Oberstdorf. Most of them are „direct trains“ without any necessary change. The time to calculate is app. 2 1/2 hours.

Other train connections are directly from the northern part of Germany to Oberstdorf via Ulm. The train ride leads you through the most beautiful area of southern Bavaria, stops in one of the oldest Roman settlements in Germany, Kempten, and brings you into Oberstdorf.

Train tickets are available at the Munich airport, Terminal 1, ground floor. The cheapest ticket is the so called “Bavarian ticket” for app. € 26,00 and covering 5 people.

By car

Munich to Oberstdorf

Motorway to Kempten either via Munich or Ulm.

Distances: Munich – Oberstdorf app. 180 km

Also easy to reach from Zürich (SUI) via St. Gallen, St. Margarethen, Bregenz.
