General

The aim of the seminar is to introduce the discipline of ice dance to all skaters and coaches and at the same time offer ice dancers of all levels the opportunity to train together. Ideally, this will lead to new partnerships on the ice.

Experienced international top coaches will moderate the seminar and introduce the athletes to the new discipline in the safest way possible. Daily off-ice classes with ballet and specific acrobatics and athletics as well as on-ice classes will be organised.

The 2024 Excellence Ice Dance Try-out Seminar is particularly aimed at the age range of novice and junior athletes.

Focus of the Seminar

- Developing new ice dance skills for young ice dancers
- Improving the skills of skaters who have already practised ice dancing
- Recommendations of future partnerships on the ice

The number of skaters and coaches registered by ISU Members is not limited, but a general guideline of a maximum of three boys and three girls per ISU Member has been set (for a maximum total number of 16 boys and 16 girls). Should too many skaters register, the CoE coordinators will reduce the number of participants according to age and level.

- The seminar is also open to coaches who wish to participate without students.
- The seminar will be held in English.
- Participants must bring their general sportswear.
- Coaches should also bring their skates

TRAVEL INFORMATION

Oberstdorf, located in the south of Germany, is easy to reach.

By plane

Airport Munich – official airport

Airport shuttle-train to Munich main station (follow the green signs to S1 or S8). The train needs 45 min. to reach Munich main station, where you need to change for train on platform 29 – 36 to the departure platform for Oberstdorf.

By train

Munich Main Station - official train station

Nearly every hour a train is running from Munich to Oberstdorf. Most of them are „direct trains“ without any necessary change. The time to calculate is app. 2 1/2 hours.

Other train connections are directly from the northern part of Germany to Oberstdorf via Ulm. The train ride leads you through the most beautiful area of southern Bavaria, stops in one of the oldest Roman settlements in Germany, Kempten, and brings you into Oberstdorf.

Train tickets are available at the Munich airport, Terminal 1, ground floor. The cheapest ticket is the so called “Bavarian ticket” for app. € 26,00 and covering 5 people.

By car

Munich to Oberstdorf

Motorway to Kempten either via Munich or Ulm.

Distances: Munich – Oberstdorf app. 180 km

Also easy to reach from Zürich (SUI) via St. Gallen, St. Margarethen, Bregenz.
