OVERVIEW

The Italian Ice Sports Federation (Federazione Italiana Sport del Ghiaccio) and the Figure Skating Club Young Goose Academy are pleased to organize for the first time an International Ice Dance Competition in Egna/Neumarkt, Italy.

GENERAL

The 2018 Egna Dance Trophy will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2017, the Special Regulations for Ice Dance 2017 and the Technical Rules for Ice Dance 2017, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108 paragraph 3. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030. Passports of the skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

COMPETITION VENUE

All practice and competition will take place at the Wuertharena Neumarkt Address Via Brennero, 7 39044 Egna/Neumarkt, Italy.

This complex features an indoor ice rinks, temperature controlled with two (2) ice surfaces 60m x 30m.

The organizer will cover accommodation for accepted judges and invited officials. Meals for accepted judges and invited officials will be provided at the arena during the days of competition.

JUDGES, REFEREES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the Wuertharena ice rink upon arrivals. The accreditation desk will be open from Thursday, February 1, 2018. Accreditation as a team member will be given to all drawn judges, competitors, one coach per competitor and one chaperone per competitor.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

The Organizing Committee will organize transfers from/to **Verona International Airport**. The service has an additional Fee of **100,00** €(round trip fee) to be paid together with the Entry Fee
