Basic Novice - Advanced Novice Junior - Senior Ladies and Men The Italian Figure Skating Federation (Federazione Italiana Sport del Ghiaccio) and the Figure Skating Club Young Goose Academy is pleasured to origanize the Egna Spring Trophy in Egna/Neumarkt, Italy.

### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

The EGNA SPRING TROPHY will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regu-lations 2016, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the EGNA SPRING TROPHY is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 ATHLETES

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation and by sending an

email to egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com. The official entry form has to be used and skaters must

send to the OC a copy of their passport at the time of entries, as well as ISU Clearence Certificate

if applicable. The lack of one of these documents makes it an invalid registration. The entries of



the host member are not limited. Please note that the organizer may divide categories with too many entries into subgroups.

Entries must reach the Event Organizer not later than March 18th, 2018.

Entry Forms, Program Content Sheet and additional forms can be downloaded from ISU website.

3.2 JUDGES

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge, not later than March 18th, 2018. The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be noti-fied of the result of the draw. Each panel of Judges in Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novices and Novices Basic categories will consist of 5 Judges.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Control-lers, the Technical Specialist, the Data and Replay Operators and the confirmed Judges at the Hotel Andreas Hofer - Egna, beginning with dinner on Wednesday, April 04, 2018 until lunch on Sunday, April 08, 2018.

The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

# 4. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry, has to be done till **March 25st, 2018**. For any later cancellation the team leader of respective Federation will be asked to pay the entry fee.

Seniors, Junior and Advanced Novice 80 Euro per skater

Pairs 120 Euro (60 Euro per skater)

7. MUSIC

Music will be reproduced on Compact Disc - CD. In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1, all

discs must show the Competition Event. Competitor's name, the Nation and the exact running

time of the music (not ska-ting time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the

time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate

disc. In addition competitors must provide a back-up drive for each program.

8. LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or

property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials. In accordance with Rule

119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2018 Egna Dance Trophy to

provide medical and acci-dent insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the



Member's team. Such insurance must be assure full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

# 9. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the Wuertharena ice rink. The accreditation desk will be open starting Wed-nesday, April 4, 2018 from 5.30 pm to 8.00 pm. All persons to be accredited are kindly asked to accredit upon arrival. Accreditation will be given to Officials and ISU Office Holders. Accreditation as a team member will be given to all drawn judges, competitors, one coach per competitor, and one chaperone per competitor.

## **10. DRAW**

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held on Monday, April 02 at 7.00 pm. The draw will be made by electronic extraction with the ISU Calculation system.

No draw after short programs. Starting order for free programs will be according the reverse of the results of short programs.

## 11. ADDITIONAL PRACTICE

Rates for additional practice hours are as follow: 25 minutes practice together with other skaters − 10 € per skater

Just first three places will be awarded with victory ceremony
