## 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Nordics will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Figure Skating & Ice Dance 2018, as well as all updated ISU Communications.

Participation in the **The Nordics** is open to all **Advanced Novice Girls & Boys** belonging to the following ISU Members:

**Norges Skøyteforbund**  
**Svenska Konståkningsförbundet**  
**Suomen Taitoluisteliitto**  
**Dansk Skøjte Union**  
**Íslenska Skautasambandið**

and qualify with regard to eligibility according to ISU Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in ISU Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

***Passports/EU ID cards of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.***

Please note that The Nordics Open for Junior and Senior Ladies and Men, which is open to **ALL ISU MEMBERS**, will take place at the same time.

***Details are stated in a separate announcement.***

## 2. TECHNICAL DATA

**Main arena (MR): DNB-Arena, Ishockeyveien 1, 4021 Stavanger**

An indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 26 x 61 m, air-conditioned and heated,

**Practice arena (PR): Siddishallen, Ishockeyveien 7, 4021 Stavanger**

An indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 26 x 58 m, air-conditioned and heated, but colder than the main rink.

The rinks are located 5 min (4 km) drive from City Center of Stavanger, and 15 min (15 km) drive from the airport. There is a 2 min walk between the rinks. The hotel **Clarion Hotel Energy** is next to DNB-Arena. The airport bus stops outside the hotel/arena.

**ADVANCED NOVICE BOYS** Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair 2018 and ISU Communication 2242. Age requirements according to ISU Communication 2242. Figure Skating Guidelines 2018 for International Novice competitions.

Short Program duration 2 min. and 20 sec +/-10 sec

Free Skating 3 min. +/- 10 sec

**ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS** Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair 2018 and ISU Communication 2242. Age requirements according to ISU Communication 2242. Figure Skating Guidelines 2018 for International Novice competitions.

Short Program duration 2 min. and 20 sec +/-10 sec

Free Skating 3 min. +/- 10 sec

### 3. ENTRIES

Complete Final Entry Forms must reach the organizer by **January 8<sup>th</sup> 2019 – 20:00 local time NORWAY** at the latest.

#### Entries of competitors

Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure: In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the Nationality of the Member, which they have been entered or who although having such nationality, have in the past representing another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Each invited Member from the **Nordic countries** has the right to enter competitors as follows:

#### 4 Novice Boys

#### 4 Novice Girls

The registration of all competitors must be entered and all judges nominated only through their respective Member Association/Federation. The age of each competitor must be stated on the Entry Form and be clearly documented.

#### Entries of officials

The host Nordic country member is responsible for appointing Referees and Technical panels for all categories, following initial suggestions from the Nordic country members as well as for the appointment of the Judges panels.

Each Nordic country member is responsible for providing at least one (1) international or ISU level judge, and at least one (1) technical panel member, but maximum two (2) Technical Controllers or Specialists. A minimum total of 3 officials.

All other ISU members can enter judges.

The Host country completes the panels of Officials according to the ISU Rules and relevant Communications regarding world standing points and officials' activity.

#### Entry fee

The entry fee is **75 €** per skater and a minimum of **250 €** per Nordic Member. In addition each Nordic country pays a contribution of **500 €**.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason after January 8<sup>th</sup>. Entry fee must be paid by **January 20<sup>th</sup> 2020** through invoice to be sent out immediately after the final entry day.

### 4. MEETINGS FOR OFFICIALS AND JUDGES

All Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and Judges are responsible to make their travel arrangements in order to be able to attend the respective event related meetings. If any other party makes the flight arrangements, the Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and the Judges are responsible to check if such arrangements are in line with the detailed schedule as mentioned under paragraph 17

## 5. EXPENSES

All expenses for skaters, coaches and team leaders must be covered by the members.

The organizer will cover meals and hotels for entered judges outside the Nordic Members.

Each participating Nordic Member must bear all expenses for their Judges, Technical Panel (TC/TS/DO/RO). The meals (lunch and dinner) and pocket money for the Technical Panel members are borne by the Organizer. The organizer will cover all expenses for invited referees.

If a Nordic country does not provide a judge and a technical panel person from their own country, the Country must cover the costs of one judge/technical panel person invited by the organizer. Travel and accommodation expenses will be paid only for the invited Referees, invited Technical Panel Members and invited Judges from outside Nordic countries.

Hotel rooms for skaters, coaches, team leaders and officials must be booked through the Organizer **only**. Chaperones must book their own hotel.

## 6. MUSIC AND PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

Music files in mp3 **are requested** to be uploaded on web links not later than **January 15<sup>th</sup>**. See page 8.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1 all Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality in digital audio file. Music files must be submitted on CD or USB on site at the time of registration. The medium with the music files will be kept until the end of the competition.

Each program (short/free) must be recorded on one track respectively on a separate medium. Mediums must show the competition event, competitors name, nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The "Planned Program Content Sheet" and "Music Information form" must be returned with the entry forms no later than **January 8th, 2020**. The Planned Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the Terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

The Organizing Committee kindly asks **all Members** to upload their **National Anthem**, thank you.

## 7. REGISTRATION

Accreditation will be given to all Referees, Judges, Technical Panels, Competitors, Team Leaders, Coaches and Representatives from each Member Federation. Accreditation will be given at the official hotel upon arrival.

## 8. PRACTICE

Official practice for Competitors begins on Thursday, February 6th (Adv.Novice/Junior). Official practice for Seniors is Saturday and Sunday morning.

It is possible to book unofficial practice ice in the Wednesday 12:00-19:00. 15 Euro pr. skater, 50 min session. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration.

## **9. RESULTS AND FREE SKATING STARTING ORDER**

Judging and calculations will be done according to ISU Special Regulations Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2018, Rules 352 and 353.

The starting order for the Free Skating will be in reverse order of the result of the Short Program according to ISU Rule 513 2.

## **10. AWARDS**

The three best-placed Competitors in each event will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists. The national anthem of the winner will be played and the flag of the medal winners hoisted.

## **11. ISU WORLD STANDINGS/MINIMUM POINTS**

World Standing points will also be awarded according to the "ISU World Standings Procedure", that can be found on the ISU website ([www.isu.org](http://www.isu.org)) under Single & Pairs/Ice Dance – World Standings. (Comm.1629 or updated document)

Minimum points will be possible to reach if the number of skaters and nations are according to rules.

## **12. LIABILITY**

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each member participation in The Nordics 2020, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred by competitors and officials.

## **13. ANTI-DOPING**

Anti-Doping tests may be carried out in accordance with the current ISU Anti-Doping Rules and Procedures (ISU Communication 2213 and 2243 or any further update of this Communication).

### Meals

All meals have to be pre booked on the Meal Form. Meal tickets will be given out per country at the accreditation on site.

Lunch is served at DNB-Arena, dinner is served at the hotel.

The meals will be paid by invoice to be sent out after the final entry day.

### The Official Dinner

The Official Dinner for the Officials, coaches and skaters will be held on **Friday evening 20:00** at Clarion Hotel Energy. The dinner cost is 365,- NOK/ person.

All banquet tickets must be booked by each Member on the meal form. The dinner will be paid by invoice to be sent out after the final entry day.

Meal tickets will be distributed to the Team Leaders at the time of registration according to bookings. Time for meals will be announced in due time.

## 15. TRANSPORTATION

The official hotel and arenas is located approx 15.min drive from Stavanger Sola Airport (15 km). The airport bus stops outside the hotel. There will be no official transport from the airport, however the organizer will have staff at the airport to direct you to the Airport bus. The bus leaves the airport 2 times per hour. The hotel **Clarion Hotel Energy** is next to DNB-Arena.
