The Italian Figure Skating Federation (Federazione Italiana Sport del Ghiaccio) and the Figure Skating Club Young Goose Academy is pleasured to origanize the Egna Spring Trophy in Egna/Neumarkt, Italy.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

The EGNA SPRING TROPHY will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the EGNA SPRING TROPHY is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 ATHLETES

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation and by sending an email to egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com.

The official entry form has to be used and skaters must send to the OC a copy of their passport and PPC document at the time of entries, as well as ISU Clearence Certificate if applicable.

The lack of one of these documents makes it an invalid registration.

Each Guest Federation can enter maximum 3 skaters per category plus 2 subsitutes.

Depending on the number of participants the organization will decide whether or not to accept extra entries. The entry of the host member is not limited.

Please note that the organizer may divide categories with too many entries into subgroups formed by age.

Entries must reach the Event Organizer not later than March 1st, 2020.

Entry Forms, Program Content Sheet and additional forms can be downloaded from ISU website.

3.2 JUDGES

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge, not later than March 1st, 2020. The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw. Each panel of Judges in Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novices categories will consist of 5 Judges. The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialist, the Data and Replay Operators.

The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

4. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry, has to be done untill **March 15th, 2020**. For any later cancellation the team leader of respective Federation will be asked to pay the entry fee.





5. ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee must be paid not later than **March 1st, 2020**. All later payments will be considered <u>late entry fee.</u>

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials. In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2020 Egna Spring Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must be assure full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

9. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the Würtharena ice rink. The accreditation desk will be open starting Thursday, March 26, 2020 from 5.30 pm to 7.30 pm. All persons to be accredited are kindly asked to accredit upon arrival. Accreditation will be given to Officials and ISU Office Holders.

10. DRAW

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held on Thursday, March 26 at 6.30 pm at the Bar Bistro Würtharena.

No draw after short programs. Starting order for free programs will be according the reverse of the results of short programs.

11. AWARDING CEREMONY

Just first three places will be awarded with victory ceremony. No prize money are provided.
