The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the "Icelab International Cup 2020" if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) the decision or recommendation of the national/local Government will not agree to conduct such an event or if the travel restrictions into and out of Italy will block the Teams for an unexpected period of time.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Icelab International Cup 2020** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation at **Icelab International Cup 2020** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors for Juniors Single & Pairs skating category must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 Entries of Competitors

All ISU Members, which are member of National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part to the **Icelab International Cup 2020**.

All entries must be entered by the respective Member Federation. Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate two (2) competitors + one (1) substitute in each category.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right for all categories to accept entries that are over of the limit of the number of participants mentioned here above.

3.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate one (1) judge who has at least the qualification "Judge for International Competitions".

In case of too many nominated judges, the organizing committee will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

3.3 Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one Coach per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Only two Team Officials of each Member, including the Member President provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of

the Head Office of their Federation, will be accredited. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation. An accompanying person to a Judge will only be accepted for accreditation if this person is a partner in life or a relative of the Judge. The Member Federations guarantee that the requested accreditation of Team Members will correspond to their function within the team and the Federation.

The names of all team members must be submitted via e-mail to <u>icelabinternationalcup@ice-lab.it</u> and <u>figura@fisg.it</u> and must reach the Organizing Committee not later Friday, October 18, 2020 – 24:00 h local time Bergamo.

3.4 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

90.00 € per pair

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizing Committee has to reduce the entries.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2, all competitors shall furnish at their arrival at the accreditation competition music of excellent quality on CD in any other approved format. All discs must show the Competitor's name, The Nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded a separate disc.

9. ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the **Ice Rink** upon arrival. Accreditation will start on Thursday Nov 5, 2020 at 12:00 a.m.

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per participating team, one Coach per Competitor, a maximum of two Team Officials of ISU Members (including the Member President), provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation and a maximum of two medical persons. Accreditation will only be granted to persons in those various functions if officially entered and named through their ISU Member.

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests. Chaperons will not receive accreditation. They need to purchase a valid ticket.

10. DRAW

The draw for the order of skating will be held on Monday November 2nd, 2020 at the Headquarter of Federazione Italiana Sport del Ghiaccio using "Random Calc Starting Order" and will be available on our Facebook page: https://www.facebook.com/lceLabBergamo

For the Free Skating segment the reverse order of places in the Short Program do determine the starting order.

11. RESULTS

Judging and calculations will be done according to ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2018. Rule 352 and 353

The three best-placed skaters/couples in each event will be announced and honoured at the official Victory Ceremony.

12. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Icelab International Competition 2020, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.
