WELCOME

Ukrainian figure skating Federation & Figure skating school "Leader" are glad to invite you and your club to participate in AUTUMN TALENTS CUP UKRAINE 2021 International Competition.

The Organizers reserve the right to change the date, location, and program of the competition. When submitting an entry all competitors acknowledge that due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and public health issues the Organizers can only host the competition in accordance with the effective medical and government regulations and has the solemn right to cancel the competition at any time or to host it between closed doors with a limited number of competitors and no spectators. The competitors also acknowledge that in case laws forbid it the Organizers are unable to hold the competition. Furthermore, in case the competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues the Organizers bear no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the Organizers. The Organizers are not obliged to assign a new date for the competition if it is cancelled because of the above-mentioned reasons. The competitors acknowledge that upon cancellation of the competition they do not have the right to claim back the already paid entry fee as the Organizers had various costs concerning the competition.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

<u>The Autumn Talents Cup Ukraine 2021</u> will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2021, and the relevant ISU Communications.

All Members of the ISU are invited to take part in the competition. Competitors participating in Senior and Junior categories must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

ISU Members, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 2 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must present an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all skaters and the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

3. ENTRIES

ISU Members must enter their competitors using the entry forms. All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation/Association.

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants in each category in case of overcrowding. Entries by names, as well as "Program Content Sheet", **must be sent not later than 17th October 2021**. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.



<u>Entries of Judges</u>: each participating Federation should nominate one judge with the qualification "Judge for International competitions" or "ISU Judge". The judges have to be on the current ISU list of judges (ISU Communication No. 2337). The organizer decides on the composition of the panel of judges. In case of too many nominated judges, the organizer will draw the judges' panel after the entries' closing date. The written confirmation will be sent to each federation immediately. All judges must be entered through their respective Member Federation/Association. Entries must be sent not later than 13th October 2021. Initial Judges meeting is planned on <u>27th October 2021</u>. Round Table Discussions are planned 30 minutes after each category.

<u>Entries of Team Officials</u>: Official entries of Team Leaders, Team Officials, Coaches/Choreographers, Team Medical staff, etc., must be made together with Competitors and Judges' entries using the official entry forms.

4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee must be paid at the "<u>Terminal</u>" Ice Rink during the Accreditation.

90 EURO / person, 130 EURO / couple

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

5. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the Officials. The organizer will not cover any expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches, etc.

6. PRACTICE

The official practices for Competitors start on October 27^{th} , 2021. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration.

7. ACCREDITATION

The official <u>accreditation</u> is planned at the "Terminal" Ice rink, date and time will be announced later.

In accordance with the ISU Directive please note that at the time of registration (Entry fee, music, hotel arrangements) we have to copy and file the passport of the Skaters (in case you happen to send it by e-mail beforehand it will make us very happy).

In case of updated COVID-19 measures there might be additional restrictions for chaperones presence during the competitions as a spectators.

8. ACCOMMODATION

All participants must book and pay the accommodation by themselves. The Organizer will make room arrangements for INVITED officials only.

9. TRANSPORTATION

11. PRACTICES

Pair Skating and Ice Dance: 15 ${\ensuremath{\mathbb C}}$ / couple / session

During practices we play the respective music once for each skater/couple.

12. DRAW

The opening draw for International competition will be done electronically on Tuesday, 26th October, 2021.

Free Skating draw will be done in reverse to result order after publication of Short Program results. The starting orders and the final time schedule shall be published on the competition website <u>www.talentscup.org</u> at the same date.

13. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- The ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (<u>autumntalents@gmail.com</u>) until 17th October 2021. Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.
- Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s): Example:

- CZE_Senior Pairs_SP_EXAMPLE-Julie_EXAMPLE-John
 The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

- Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient. Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee

14. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 352, and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

15. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Spring Talents Cup 2021 to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials, and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance, including COVID-19, and return to the home country by air transport or other expeditious means of the ill or injured person. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability concerning a bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.



16. VICTORY CEREMONY

The three best-placed skaters in each ISU event will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. Due to the COVID-19 and the social distancing, all the information regarding the ceremonies will be detailed in the competition schedule.
