The Challenge Cup will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2021 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Challenge Cup is for skaters who belong to an invited ISU Member, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 2 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must present an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 Entries of Competitors

Each ISU Member can enter **up to three (3)** skaters/couples in each category. For the Senior events, preference will be given to skaters in accordance with their placement on the ISU World Standings ranking list, as per closing date of the entries by name. For the other categories, preference will be given to those ISU Members which sent entries by number, in order of receipt of such entries. A reserve-list will be kept up to date on a daily basis. In case of too many entries, the Organizer may reduce the final entries.

The organizing committee reserves the option in the competition to allow late entries, reserved for competitors preparing for the (Junior) World Figure Skating championships, and/or needing the competition to obtain the minimum technical score as written in ISU Communication 2395. A reserve-list will be kept up to date on a daily basis.

b) Entries by Number

The entries by number indicating the number of skaters/couples in the disciplines concerned must be submitted by e-mail not later than **December 31**, **2021** to the **Organizing Committee Challenge Cup** by e-mail: <u>challengecup@knsb.nl</u>.

In case no entry is received by **December 31, 2021** it will be assumed that your federation will not participate.

d) Entry fee

An entry fee of \in 85,- per single skater (Adv.Novice/Junior/Senior), \in 60,- per Basic Novice skater and \in 140,- per pair/ice dance couple (Junior/Senior) will be asked and has to be paid after confirmation of the official entry by name.

Invoices will be sent to the federations in advance.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

When we receive entries after the entry deadline of January 24, 2022, the entry fee will be increased to:

- € 70,- per Basic Novice skater
- € 95,- per single skater (Adv.Novice/Junior/Senior)
- € 150,- per pair/ice dance couple

e) Transportation

We will provide transportation (paid) between Eindhoven airport/Schiphol airport/Brussel airport and Tilburg for the teams and between the official hotels and ice rink.

All team members (incl. Judges), except invited Officials have to pay this transportation fee.

We will also provide a shuttle service from Thursday February 24 till Sunday February 27 between the official hotels and the ice rink for € 50,- per person. This shuttle will run at 30 minutes intervals and the transfer will take about 10 minutes.

Separate invoices will be send to the federations in advance.

As soon as the transportation fee has been paid, no refund is possible.

3.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one ISU or International Judge and one substitute Judge.

The official entry form for Judges must reach the Organizing Committee not later than January 24, 2022.

Each panel of Judges will consist of 5 judges. In case of a too high number of entered Judges, the Organizing Committee will make a draw and inform ISU Members before **February 5, 2022** whether Judges have been drawn or not drawn. For the Ice Dance panel, first priority will be given to Judges who are qualified as International- or ISU Judge in both Singles & Pairs and in Ice Dance.

3.3 Team Leaders meeting

The Team Leaders meeting will be held online on **Thursday 17 February, 19.30 hrs**. Each participating team must enter a Team Leader and write down his/her **email address** and **mobile phone number** on the entry form C1. Team Leaders will receive an invitation by email.

3.4 Draw for starting order

The draw will be held online (online is approved by the ISU) on <u>Wednesday February 23, at 17.00</u> in presence of one of the Referees, in accordance with Rule 512 and 513 of the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021.

The starting order for the Free Skating shall be based on the reverse order of the result of the Short Program.

4. EXPENSES, MEALS, LODGING

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for Judges and invited Officials participating, beginning with dinner on **February 23, 2022** and ending with lunch on **February 27, 2022**, in accordance with their travel plan and scheduled activities.

The expenses for rooms and meals for the Team Leader, Coaches, Competitors and other team officials will not be covered by the organizer and are on the account of the team.

Should any Judge or invited Official arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

All extra expenses incurred by any Official will be the responsibility of that person and must be paid prior to departure.

5. PRACTICE

The official practices for competitors start on **February 24, 2022 / <u>appr. 08:00 hrs</u>**. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration.

6. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT / PRESS FORMS

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD or in any other approved format, in accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations, paragraph 1. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Program for Single and Pairs, for the Exhibition must be

listed for each Competitor on the official Music Selection Form and attached to the official Entry Form for Competitors.

We prefer to receive your competition music digital on MP3 format (the file format must be MP3). This MP3 file must have Competitor's name, Member's name, the category and segment and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. The competition music must be uploaded in the google doc form via https://forms.gle/ZGWZbEj2tvGQ1uMc9 before the entry deadline of January 24, 2022. Competitors must provide a backup drive (USB stick) for each program.

If music information is not complete and discs/MP3 not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The best placed team will be announced and honored with the International Challenge Cup. In case of a draw the highest number of first and/or second and/or third places will be taken into account.

For the National Championship, the three best placed Dutch skaters/couples in each category will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medallists.
