ANNOUNCEMENT

Merano Ice Trophy is a new ISU International Competition organized by the Federazione Italiana Sport del Ghiaccio (FISG) and the local figure skating club ASM (Associazione Sportiva Merano Sezione Pattinaggio). The goal of this event is to bring Figure Skating Family to the beautiful city of Merano in the heart of Italian Alps.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Merano Ice Trophy is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to ISU Constitution and General Regulations Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in ISU Rule 108, paragraph 3.a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirement in ISU Rule 109, and ISU Communication No. 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Entries can only be made through the ISU Members.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

3. CATEGORIES

SENIOR WOMEN AND MEN

Short Program	The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2. Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.
Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value. Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR WOMEN AND MEN

Short Program	The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2021/22 (and listed in ISU Communication 2382). Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.
Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value. Duration: 3 minutes and 30 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS AND BOYS

Short Program	Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2396 and all respective ISU Communications. Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.
Free Skating	Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2396 and all respective ISU Communications. Duration: 3 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 ATHLETES

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation and by sending an email to merano.icetrophy@gmail.com and figura@fisg.it. The official entry form has to be used and skaters must send to the OC a copy of their passport and PPC document at the time of entries, as well as ISU Clearance Certificate if applicable. The lack of one of these documents makes it an invalid registration. Each Guest Federation can enter maximum 3 competitor per category plus 1 substitute, no limits for Italian Federation. Depending on the number of participants the organization will decide whether or not to accept extra entries.

The organizing committee reserves the option in the competition to allow late entries in Senior Ladies and Men and 2 late entries in Senior Pairs, reserved for competitors preparing for the World Figure Skating championships, and/or needing the competition to obtain the minimum technical score as written in ISU Communication 2332. A reserve-list will be kept up to date on a daily basis.

Entries must reach the Event Organizer not later than January 1st, 2022.

Entry Forms, Program Content Sheet and additional forms can be downloaded from ISU website.

4.2 JUDGES

EXPENSES, MEALS, LODGING

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for Judges and invited officials participating, beginning with dinner on **February 3, 2022** and ending with lunch on **February 6, 2022**.

The expenses for rooms and meals for the Team Leader, Coaches, Competitors and other team officials will not be covered by the organizer and are on the account of the team.

Should any Judge or invited Official arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for travel, rooms and meals also for the invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

All extra expenses incurred by any Official will be the responsibility of that person and must be paid prior to departure.

4.3 CANCELLATION

Cancellation of competitors, has to be done within **JANUARY, 15, 2022**. For any later cancellation the team leader of respective Federation will be asked to pay the entry fee.

5. ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee must be paid not later than January 15th, 2022. After that date, all the payments will be considered **LATE ENTRY FEE**.

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a MP3 file.

8. LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials.

Furthermore the OC is not responsible for any contagion that occurs at the event outside of compliance with the prevention protocols implemented.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2022 Merano IceTrophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must be assure full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

9. ACCREDITATION

The accreditation will be taking place at the Meranarena Ice rink starting on **THURSDAY, February 3, 2022.**

10. DRAW

Considering the current Covid-19 situation and to avoid unnecessary gatherings, the draw will be made in the headquarter of the Italian Ice Sports Federation - FISG on **THURSDAY, January 27, 2022.** Starting order for the free skating of all the categories will be in reverse order of the results of the short program.

11. AWARDING CEREMONY

The three best placed skaters/couples in each event will be announced and honored.
