Interclub Figure Skating Competition in single skating for Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice, Cubs, Chicks

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Abu Dhabi Classic Trophy** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Abu Dhabi Classic Trophy** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must procedure and ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

The results of the **Abu Dhabi Classic Trophy** will count towards the results of the Open UAE National Championship. In a separate medal ceremony, the UAE National Champion will be awarded. Only UAE Nationals qualify for this title.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to enter additional skaters in each category and limit entries in any event in case of too many entries.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

Place of the Event

All competition events as well as official practices will take place at the Zayed Sports City Ice Rink (an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30×60 m, air-conditioned and heated).

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS







Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2007 and younger

Free Skating: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2009 and younger

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CUBS GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2012 - 30.6.2014

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum:
- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation: For CUBS, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for Level Requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The program components will be judged only according to the following criteria:

- Skating Skills
- Performance

The factors for the program components are 2.5.







CHICKS GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2014 and younger

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.

- c) There must be a maximum:
- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation: For CHICKS, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for Level Requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The program components will be judged only according to the following criteria:

- Skating Skills
- Performance

The factors for the program components are 2.5.







3. ENTRIES

All ISU members and clubs, which are members of National Skating Federations, are invited to take part in the competition.

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

The organizer will not cover any expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches, or chaperons.

4. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry must be done till **February 27, 2023**. For any later cancellation, applicants will be asked to pay the entry fee.

8. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- the ISU Member / Club is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (events@adisc.ae) until 6th March 2023. Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.
- each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

Example:

GBR_Junior Men_SP_EXAMPLE-John GBR Junior Men FS EXAMPLE-John

- The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- CDs can also be accepted by the Organizing Committee if there's no possibility to provide music in other format.

9. REGISTRATION OFFICE

The office of the organizing committee and the registration office will be located at the ice rink and will be open every day during the competition. Participating teams are kindly asked to announce changes to their teams as early as possible but at the latest immediately after the arrival of the team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition. The Organizer holds no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

All participants must be aware that the organizer is not responsible for any injury. Each participant must have health insurance valid in the UAE.

11. RESULTS

The ISU Judging System as described in the ISU Technical Rule Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and Publication of Results) will be used.

12. DRAW

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held electronically.

Starting order for the free skating will be in reverse order of the results of the short program.
