The Nice Baie des Anges Association and the Fédération Française des Sports de Glace are pleased to announce the Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating 2023, an international competition in figure skating for Senior & Junior Competition for Men, Women, Pairs skating and Ice Dance.

The Trophy Metropole Nice Côte d'Azur, as all international ISU calendar competitions will provide athletes opportunities to improve their world standing by addition of points according to ISU rules.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and b) they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

2.1 ISU MEMBER:

Fédération Française des Sports de Glace

2.2 DATES:

The competition will be held in Nice, from October 18th to 23rd, 2023.

2.3 VENUE:

All competition events and practice sessions will take place in the rink 60 X 30 meters of the Sports Palace Jean Bouin - Esplanade De Lattre de Tassigny - 06000 NICE.

Indoor ice-rink, air conditioned, not heated.

The Ice Rink is located in the city centre of Nice and easily accessible by tram (Stop: Palais des Expositions).



2.4 SENIOR MEN

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pairs, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2 and the respective ISU Communication.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skatina:

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced-Program" and the element values.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/-10 seconds

2.5 SENIOR WOMEN

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2 and the respective ISU Communication.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced-Program" and the element values.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds

2.6 SENIOR PAIR SKATING

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 620, paragraph 1 and 2, for 2023/2024 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skatina:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 621 and the relevant ISU Communications. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced program" and the element values.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds

2.7 SENIOR ICE DANCE

Rhythm Dance:

In accordance the ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 709, and all pertinent ISU Communications. Rhythms required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 2560, and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds, +/- 10 sec

Free Dance:

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2560 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds



2.8 JUNIOR MEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2023/24.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

2.9 JUNIOR WOMEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2023/24.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

2.10 JUNIOR PAIR SKATING

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2023/24.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2022, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

2.11 JUNIOR ICE DANCE

Rhythm Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 709.

Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 2560 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec. +/- 10 sec

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2560 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 Entries of competitors

Each ISU Member can enter up to three (3) skaters/couples in each category.

Members who have requested for extra entries will be contacted if additional places become available after the deadline.

The participation of the host member is not limited.

All entries must be made by the ISU Member concerned.

All entries must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the deadline indicated. Declarations need to be uploaded to the ORS as well.

a) Limitation of number of entries

In case of a higher number of entries, the OC may limit the number of final entries available for Members. If OC have to limit the number of entries, priority will be given to those countries that have made the Preliminary Entries.

b) Entries by Number

The preliminary entries must reach the Organizer by latest: August 31, 2023 20:00 (local time Nice). by entering the information through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS).

c) Entries by Name

The Entries by names must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) not later than September 18, 2023 20:00 (local time Nice)

3.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate up to two (2) judges ISU or International Judge and one substitute Judge. The Entries of Judges must be done through the ORS not later than September 18, 2023 20:00 (local time Nice).

Each panel of Judges will consist between 5 to 7 judges. In case of a too high number of entered Judges, the Organizing Committee will make a draw and inform ISU Members before September 30, 2023 whether Judges have been drawn or not drawn.

For the Ice Dance panel, first priority will be given to Judges who are qualified as International or ISU Judge in both Singles & Pairs and in Ice Dance.

Each judge appointed by a participating ISU member is informed that he may be solicited to compose the panels of judges in one or more disciplines, in junior or senior categories, not only in those where a skater from his country is entered.

3.3 Entries of Team Members



Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially entered in ORS and accepted by the Organizer.

3.4 Entry Fee

The entry Fee must be paid by bank transfer not later than October 10th, 2023. All later payments will be considerate late entry fee, the entry fees will be as follows:

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries.

Notice: The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation is substituting a skater, whose entry fee was paid by the deadline by another skater.

4. APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS

This Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating event will follow the principles of Rule 420, paragraph 5.a) of the ISU Special Regulations Single Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022 for appointing the event officials.

The members of each individual Technical Panel (Technical Controller and the Technical Specialists) will not be from the same ISU Member and will have at least the qualification "International".

The Referee will have at least the qualification "International" and could be of the same ISU Member as one member of the Technical Panel (Technical Controller and Technical Specialists).

The Data Operator and the Replay Operator will have at least the qualification "International".

5. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide one meal (LUNCH <u>OR</u> DINNER) for all competitors participating, during the competition and in accordance with travel opportunities before and after the event, if necessary. Each member invited, covers the travel and the hotel (bed and breakfast) for their own competitors.

The expenses for rooms and meals, travel and transfer of the Team Leaders, Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the organizer and are on the account of the Teams.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for travels, rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators participating, beginning with dinner on Tuesday October 17th, 2023 until breakfast on Monday October 23rd, 2023.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Judges, beginning with dinner on Tuesday October 17th, 2023 until breakfast on Monday October 23rd, 2023.

Should any of them arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and meals will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid by themselves, except if an arrangement has been made with the organizers.

All Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialist, the Data and Replay Operators will receive a pocket money of EUR 150.00

All judges will receive a pocket money of EUR 100.00.

6. PRACTICE

The official practice will start on Wednesday, October 18th, 2023. A detailed schedule will be posted well ahead and will also be handed out at the time of registration.

7. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

7.1 MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

• the ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music on the following weblink:

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

• each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format of WAV or MP3 file).



If the music files have been submitted within the above-mentioned deadline to the Organizing Committee, then the music team of the Organizing Committee is entirely responsible for the correct execution of the music. In case of issues with submitted music files the Organizing Committee may request at the time of registration a secondary copy of the music files. In case the music files have not been submitted in time to the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

Please note: CDs will **not** be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single, for the Rhythm and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must all be entered, in detail, by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

7.2 PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

The Planned Program Content must be entered by the ISU member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per participating team, one Coach per Competitor, a maximum of two Team Officials of ISU Members (including the Member President), provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation and a maximum of two medical persons. Accreditation will only be granted to persons in those various functions if officially entered and named through their ISU Member.

The ISU Member certifies with the signed entry form the indicated functions within the team of all team members. Any misuse of any function will be sanctioned by the ISU/OC.

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests.

An accompanying person to a Judge will only be accepted for accreditation if this person is a partner in life or a relative of the Judge.

Chaperons will not receive accreditation.

11. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

12. PRESENTATION OF TROPHY AND MEDALS

The three best-placed skaters/couples in each event will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists.

The national anthem of the winner will be played, and the flag of the medal winners hoisted.

13. PRIZE MONEY

Prizes money, earned in competition, are paid by organizers, only for skaters participating at the exhibition which is a part of the competition.

15. ANTI-DOPING CONTROLS

Anti-Doping tests may be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications No. 2344 & 2366 or later updates) and French Ministry.

16. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

The Organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the Competition.

17. EXHIBITION

The best three placed skaters/couples in the final ranking of each category will be asked to take part in an exhibition on Sunday afternoon. Additional skaters/couples will be invited to participate.

Prizes money, earned in competition, are paid by organizers, only for skaters participating at the exhibition which is a part of the competition.

18. MEETINGS FOR ISU EVENT OFFICIALS and JUDGES
