GENERAL REGULATIONS:

The Lõunakeskus Trophy will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and

General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair

Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Lõunakeskus Trophy is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU

Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages

fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation,

citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU

Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526

all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered

or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member,

must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU

Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for

verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation. Clubs

registered at ISU Members Federations can participate in competition or Invited clubs

ONLY. The OC can have a final design about over quota for any club/country/federation or

refuse to accept the entry (full or partially).

ENTRIES OF COMPETITORS:

All the members of ISU being members of National Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in this competition.

Members can enter any quantity of Skaters into each category.

In entry form all skaters names must be written in English!

NB! Changing categories for skaters is not allowed after deadline for entries! Please note, that any replacements in entry form has to be made into the same class and category. Please note, that any replacements in entry form has to be made before <u>01.02.2024</u>!

ENTRY FEES:

Before 10.01.2024

85.- EUR

After 11.01.2024

100.- EUR per skater (Men, Women, Junior)

Each club has to pay for its participants 100% of the total amount right after the entry form confirmation, by 10.01.2024

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation. Bill must be paid with one (1) transaction for all the country/member participants.

The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason.

You can replace one skater for another in same category if 100% is paid already. The entire club will not take part in draw in a case of not paid participant.

APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS / ENTRIES OF JUDGES:

This Lõunakeskus Trophy event will follow the principles of International Skating Union for appointing the event officials. The members of each individual Technical Panel, Referee and Judges will have at least the qualification "International".

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge with the qualification "Judge for International competitions" or "ISU Judge" per discipline, double duty Judges are very welcome. We cover hotel's/meal/pocket money ONLY for Judges who are acting in several panels except those where own federation skaters are presented

The Panels of Judges will consist of a minimum of five (5) Judges in all panels.

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

PLANED PROGRAM CONTENT:

The "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee before **28.01.2024.** It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be completed precisely by each skater in English using the proper terminology.

PRACTICE:

MUSIC:

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on USB flash drive. Each file shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name of the competitor.

RESULTS:

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

AWARDING:

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honored and awarded by Trophies, special presents and diplomas; others will receive memory presents.

The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please make sure that all skaters are represented at the Ceremony.

EXPENCES:

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS:

The nearest airport is Tallinn Lennart Meri Airport (TLL) with a distance of 175 km to the venue.

You can reach from Tallinn Aiport to Tartu Coach Station by bus, which departures from the airport every 30 min. You can buy bus tickets by using website www.tpilet.ee

The OC will not be providing transportation from the airport for competitors, coaches, Team

Leaders and Team Staff.

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2478, (or any update of this Communication). Action against this rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.
