General Regulations

The competitions will be held under the 2018 ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations/Technical Rules for Short Track Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2275.

Participation is open to all ISU Members. This competition is part of the ISU World Cup Short Track 2019/20.

Track Conditions

The Maurice-Richard arena has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2128 (or any further update). The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

Entries

- a) Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for World Cup Short Track Speed Skating on www.isu.org, section Short Track Speed Skating.
- b) Entries with the number of competitors, substitutes, coaches & Team leader and requirements of accommodation must be submitted by <u>September 27, 2019.</u>

In addition, please send an ID picture of each Team Member to the Organizing Committee in electronic format, not later than **November 3, 2019**, enabling the OC to prepare all accreditations in advance.

ISU Members failing to comply in time with these requirements will receive no support from the Organizing Member for:

- Hotel booking;
- Travel arrangements between airport and hotel;
- Travel arrangements between hotel and ice rink;
- Access to Closing Banquet (if held);
- Preferred times for additional training sessions.

All these costs and any additional costs incurred will be for the full account of the ISU Members concerned.

- c) Final Entries must reach the Organizing Committee using the Online Entry System must be submitted at the latest by 20:00 hrs (local time) on **November 3, 2019** (see ISU Communication No. 2275, paragraph 5), and the following information must be communicated to the Organizing Committee:
 - Names of the Competitors and substitutes per category with their International Registration Numbers;
 - Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances;
 - Confirmation of participation in the Relay.

Final Entries that do not comply with these requirements are considered Post Entries. See Rule 115.

- d) Competitors must be present in Montréal at the latest at 18:00 hours on Thursday, November 7, 2019 or the Organizing Committee must receive documented proof that the competitors are in transit and will arrive in due time for the World Cup Competition. Competitors who do not comply with these requirements will be excluded.
- e) Please note that for all persons entered by the Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628 need to be strictly observed.

Citizenships/Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2030, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

World Cup points

The points scoring at the World Cup Competition is made in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2275, paragraph 12.

Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications Nos. 2213 & 2243 or later updates).

Ice Training

The Organizing Committee will arrange free ice training on Thursday, November 7, 2019 for all participating

teams. Extra practices will be provided from November 5, 2019. Each training session (50 minutes) will be

charged 150 \$ USD. If two or more teams agree to share one training session, both (all) of them can share the

cost.

Liability

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, Speed Skating Canada and The

Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property

damage incurred in connection with the ISU World Cup Short Track Speed Skating Competition. Each Member

is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Accommodation

All teams must make their reservation themselves and should bear their own expenses for accommodation.

In order to make a reservation, teams must fill the Accommodation and travel form and send it directly to the

In order to ensure that enough meals will be prepared, teams must fill the Meals Request Form and send it directly to the appropriate person **no later than October 11, 2019**.

Please note that dinner will be served at the Closing Celebrations ONLY on Sunday, November 10, 2019.

Hotel requirements must be communicated **to them** as soon as possible, but no later than **October 11, 2019.**Also, please note that the Team leader must present a major credit card upon arrival at the hotel.

Cancellation policy: Rooms will be 100% refundable if they are cancelled before 23:59 (local time) October 13, 2019. Any cancelation after that date and time will not be refunded.

Transportation

The Organizing Committee will organize and provide one transportation each way, free of charge, for each team between Montréal–Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport (YUL) and the official hotels, from Sunday, November 3, 2019 to Monday, November 11, 2019. Expenses for team officials, who do not accompany their team members, are to be borne by themselves CAD 50.00.

The Organizing Committee will also provide transportation between the official hotels and Maurice-Richard arena during the competition days and the training periods, starting Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

The date, airline, flight number, expected time of arrival and the date and time of departure should be communicated to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but no later than **October 11, 2019.** Please include the amount of special equipment (e.g. bicycles, massage tables, etc.) that needs to be transported.
