General Regulations

The ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships 2024 will be conducted in accordance with the 2022 ISU Regulations and relevant Communications. Participation is open to all ISU Members. Entries must be made only through the respective ISU Members (Rule 131).

Track Conditions

The Hala Olivia has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2365 (or any further update). The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

Entries¹

a) Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) for Short Track Speed Skating on https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login.

b) Entries with the number of Competitors, substitutes, coaches & Team leader and requirements of accommodation must be submitted by January 11, 2024 (Rule 295, paragraph 4).

The number of other personnel travelling with the Team shall be communicated at the same time.

ISU Members failing to comply in time with these requirements will receive no support from the Organizing Member for:

- Hotel booking;

- Travel arrangements between airport and hotel;
- Travel arrangements between hotel and ice rink;
- Access to Closing Banquet (if held);
- Preferred times for additional training sessions.

All these costs and any additional costs incurred will be for the full account of the ISU Members concerned.

c) Final Entries must reach the Organizing Committee using the Online Registration System at the latest by 20:00 hrs (local time) on February 12, 2024 (Rule 295, paragraph 4), and the following information must be communicated to the Organizing Committee:

- Names of the Competitors and a list of alternate names per category with their International Registration Numbers;
- Names of the Competitors and their personal best time, recorded during the period of eligibility, for all individual distances they might participate in;
- Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances;
- Confirmation of participation in all the competitions of the Relay.

Only the Competitors listed on the Final Entry, respecting the maximum number of entries allowed, can attend and receive an accreditation for the Event.

Final Entries that do not comply with these requirements are considered Post Entries. See Rule 115.

d) Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628 need to be strictly observed. Declaration Forms must be uploaded in the ORS in each Competitors and Team Officials' profile prior submitting the Entries.

For more details, please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communication Nos. 1628 and 1797 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

¹ Reference is made to ISU Communication No. 2469, paragraph 2.a) according to which and until further notice, no individual belonging to the Russian Skating Union and Skating Union of Belarus shall be invited, entered and allowed to participate in International Competitions, ISU Championships and other ISU Events.

Individual Entries:

In accordance with Rule 283, paragraph 2.a), each ISU Member has the right to enter three (3) Competitors in each individual category Women and Men. In accordance with Rule 283, paragraph 2.b), each ISU Member, with the right to participate is entitled to enter 2 Competitors in each category for each individual distance, any two (2) of the maximum three (3) Skaters entered may skate each distance.

In accordance with ISU Communication No. 2581 "Entries for ISU Championships", the following ISU Members may enter more than two (2) Competitors in total in the respective category and distances.

Relay Entries:

ISU Members entering a Relay Team can only enter a maximum of four (4) Competitors which will include all Competitors for both competitions: Individual and Relay. For Individual distances (500, 1000 & 1500 meters), any two (2) or three (3) of the maximum four (4) Skaters entered as indicated above may skate each distance.

Qualifying Times:

Entered Skaters (including substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times over 500 meters, in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2581, paragraph 5.3, as follows: Every ISU Member can enter 1 Skater per category that has achieved the following qualifying time:

Women 500 meters:	51,85
Men 500 meters:	48,40

If an ISU Member enters more than 1 Skater, the qualifying times required for all Skaters (including all Relay Skaters) entered by the ISU Member, are:

 Women 500 meters:
 50,13

 Men 500 meters:
 46,78

For a result to be a valid qualifying time, it must have been achieved in the period between July 1, 2021 and the final entry deadline specified in the paragraph "Entries" above. Any qualifying time achieved during an ISU Event will be automatically available in the ORS, for times achieved at other events, the documentation shall be uploaded in the ORS directly for review and approval by the ISU.

Make-Up of Races

The make-up of the races over both individual and relay distances will be made in accordance with Rule 296. For the first round of the Relay races, the Seeding List will follow the Classification of the Relay competition at the ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships 2023 (Rule 283, paragraph 3.b).

Points and Classification

In accordance with Rule 295.

Titles and Medals

The winners of the Championships (according to Rule 133) will bear the title:

World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Champion 500/1000/1500 meters for 2024

World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Relay Champions for 2024

World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Mixed Team Relay Champions for 2024

The World Junior Champions will receive the ISU gold medal. The Skaters placed second and third will receive the ISU silver and bronze medals respectively.

The World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Relay Champions or World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Mixed Team Relay Champions will receive the ISU gold medal. The second and third placed Relay Teams will receive the ISU silver and bronze medals respectively.

Prize money will be awarded in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2516, or any further update of this Communication.

Ice Training

All practice sessions will take place at the Competition venue. The Organizing Committee will arrange free ice training on Wednesday, February 21, 2024 for all participating teams. Extra practices will be provided from Monday, February 19, 2024. Each training session (50 minutes) will be charged 15€ per skater. Payment for additional practice ice time must be paid in [EURO] to the Organizing Committee upon arrival. For practice ice time prior to the official practice, please inform the Organizing Committee using the attached form. Medical coverage will be provided for the official and additional practice sessions in accordance with Rule 140.

Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications Nos. 2344 & 2366 or later updates).

Liability

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, Polish Speed Skating Association and The Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships 2024. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Accommodation and Meals

The Organizing Committee will provide accommodation and meals starting with lunch on Wednesday, February 21, 2024 until lunch on Monday, February 26, 2024 (for those departing in the afternoon) for all participating Skaters, maximum four (4) Women and four (4) Men, plus one Team leader from each participating ISU Member. All costs incurred prior Wednesday, February 21, 2024 and after Monday, February 26, 2024 will be under the financial responsibility of each ISU Member and the amount due shall be settled on site, at the applicable rate, upon arrival, or in advance by bank transfer

Methods of payment: Bank transfer in advance or Cash in PLN, EUR, or Credit card; Visa, Mastercard, Diner's Club. +2% handling fee with Credit Card payment.

All arrangements for accommodation must be made through the Organizing Committee.

Official Hotels

The Organizing Committee will arrange hotel reservations for the participants at the following official hotel: Hotel Novotel Marina (Jelitkowska 20, 80-432 Gdańsk)

The cost of a room and meal at the official hotel is as follows:

- Single room (per person, per night): 140€ full board including drinks
- Double room (per person, per night): 115€ full board including drinks

*during competition days lunch will be served at the Venue, price is included in the pricelist above

Hotel Hampton by Hilton Gdańsk Old Town (Lektykarska 4, 80-831 Gdańsk)

The cost of a room and meal at the official hotel is as follows:

- Single room (per person, per night): 140€ full board including drinks
- Double room (per person, per night): 115€ full board including drinks

Cancellation policy:

30% of the reserved rooms and meals can be cancelled free of charge until January 21, 2024

10% of the reserved rooms and meals can be cancelled free of charge until February 7, 2024.

All cancellations above the mentioned limit or late cancellations will not be reimbursed or to be settled.

Hotel requirements must be communicated to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but no later than January 11, 2024

Tickets for Competitors

Competitors willing to receive 2 tickets for their family members must inform the Organizing Committee not later than January 10, 2024 In case of a limited number of available tickets, the principle of "first come, first serve" will apply. Competitors asking for tickets must provide the names of the tickets holder to the Organizing Committee.

Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide free transportation for all participants between Gdańsk International Airport or Gdańsk railway and the official hotels, from Monday, February 19 to Monday, February 26, 2024. Participants arriving and departing from other airport(s) or train/bus stations will be responsible for the transport costs.

Expenses for team members, who arrive before Monday, February 19 or for team officials who do not accompany their team members, are to be borne by themselves and will be as follows:

Gdańsk International Airport: 35€/ person/ one way.

Gdańsk Railway Station: 20€/ person/ one way.

The Organizing Committee will also provide free transportation for all participants between the official hotel and Hala Olivia during the competition days and the training periods, starting from Monday, February 19, 2024. The date, airline, flight number, expected time of arrival and the date and time of departure should be communicated to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but no later than Wednesday, February 7, 2024. Please include the amount of special equipment (e.g. bicycles, massage tables, etc.) that needs to be transported.

Medical Insurance

It is the sole responsibility of each ISU Member participating in an ISU Event (as defined in Rule 107), to provide medical insurance for their Skaters. Proof of such can be requested by the Organizing Committee.

Entry Visa Requirements

Should you need assistance to obtain a Polish entry visa or require a specific letter of invitation, please contact the Organizing Committee.

Media Accreditation
