REGULATIONS

The ISU Four Continents Single Distances Speed Skating Championships 2023 will be held in accordance with the 2022 Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU), relevant ISU Communications, in particular ISU Communication No. 2514, and Guidelines for ISU Events During the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Participation in the Championships is open to skaters who belong to a Four Continents ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 2) and who have met the qualification criteria according to Rule 208 and ISU Communication No. 2514.

TRACK

The <u>Centre de glaces Intact Assurance</u> is an indoor artificially frozen ice rink with a standard track of 400 meters and inner and outer curves with radii of 26 and 30 meters respectively. The width of the inside training track is 4.5 meters. In accordance with Rue 228 a protective moveable padding system will be installed around the track.

TITLE AND AWARDS

The winners of the individual/team races will bear the titles: "Women Four Continents____ Speed Skating Champion for 2023" and "Four Continents ____ Speed Skating Champion for 2023", respectively. All winners will be awarded the ISU Championships gold medal. The Skaters or teams placed second and third will be awarded the ISU Championships silver and bronze medals, respectively. See Rule 133, paragraph a).

Prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2368, or any further update of this Communication.

ENTRIES

Entries for the ISU Four Continents Single Distances Speed Skating Championships 2023 will only be accepted for Skaters who have reached the qualifying times for the event concerned, as listed in ISU Communication No. 2514, paragraph 4.2.1.

Four Continents ISU Members may enter a maximum of three (3) Skaters in each individual distance, except for Mass Start Women and Mass Start Men where the maximum entry quotas per Four Continents ISU Member is two (2). The specific entry quotas for each ISU Member will be announced by the ISU following the results of the qualifying competitions (ISU World Cup Speed Skating Competitions in Stavanger, NOR, and Heerenveen, NED, held in November 2022), in accordance with Rule 208, paragraph 2.5, some ISU Members have been preallocated entry quotas as indicated in ISU Communication No. 2514, paragraph 3.2.1.e).

The total number of Competitors for each distance will be limited as follows:

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication 1628 need to be strictly observed.

CITIZENSHIP/RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS AND CLEARANCE PROCEDURE

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2030, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

DRAWING

The drawing will be made in accordance with Rules 239, 240 (paragraph 5) and 242.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

LIABILITY

In accordance with the ISU General Regulations (Rule 119), the ISU, Speed Skating Canada and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with this Championship. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

FACE MASKS

No advertising marking is allowed on face masks. Face masks may display one (1) manufacturer trademark/identification of maximum 8cm². In addition, ISU Member's name and/or abbreviation and/or national flag and/or Skater's name may be displayed on the face mask.

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from Monday, November 28, 2022. Trial starts will be organized on Thursday, December 1, 2022.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

ISU Members may ask for changes in the training schedule latest by November 18, 2022. Decisions on requested changes will be taken by the Organizing Committee in consultation with the ISU.

BOARD AND LODGING

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for expenses for board and lodging at the official hotel from lunch on Thursday, December 1, 2022, until lunch on Monday, December 5, 2022 (Rule 137 paragraphs 10 and 14) for all Competitors participating in the Championships (not for the substitutes) and 1 Team leader or coach for each ISU Member. Expenses of other Skaters and officials (i.e., coaches, other team staff members and accompanying persons) other than those mentioned above, and expenses before or after the period mentioned above, will be at their own expense.

Accommodation requests can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from November 27 to December 5 from and to the <u>Jean-Lesage International Airport</u>. Transfers must be requested in the OES no later than **November 14, 2022**. Team officials who do not travel together with their team cannot be guaranteed this transportation service.

Teams wishing to arrange their own transfer may consider taxis, ride sharing and/or rental cars as options.

A shuttle bus service will be available between the official hotel(s) and the ice-rink from Monday, November 28.

The Organizing Committee must be informed via the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events about the date and time of arrival and departure of the Competitors and officials as soon as possible, but at the latest by November 14, 2022.

VISA REQUIREMENTS & COVID-19 PANDEMIC ACCESS RESTRICTIONS

A visitor visa may be required for participants and team officials. Please contact Speed Skating Canada at worldcup@speedskating.ca if you need an invitation letter for the visa.

Please provide participant names, roles and passport information to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, in order to have the necessary visas completed in due time.

The organizer is not obliged to provide services (accommodation, accredited entrance to the ice rink, transportation, etc.) for an excessive number of team officials or other accompanying persons from participating ISU Members. A fee of EUR 250 (charged in local currency) for each extra Team Officials/Federation Officials accreditation must be paid to the Organizing Committee.
