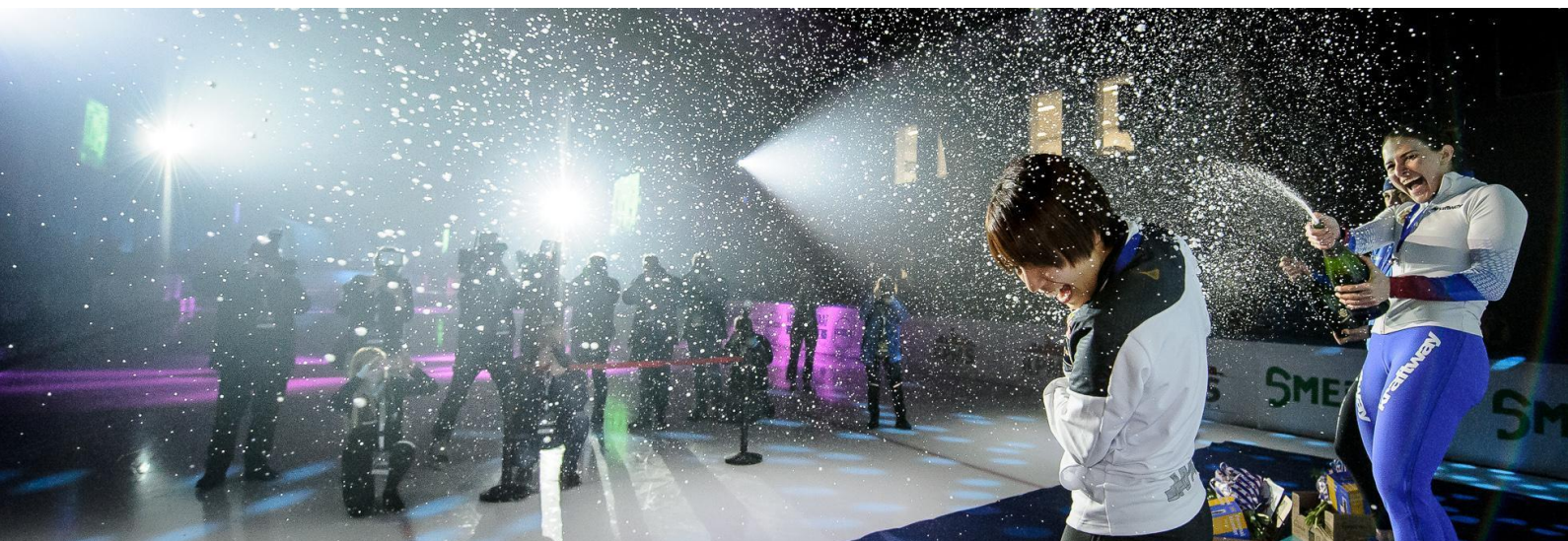

Competition

De Zilveren Bal, "The Silver Ball", is a 100 meter sprint Championship. It is the world's fastest skate show. It is an event where the combination of high-level sports and entertainment gives a unique experience to both participants and spectators. Each time three skaters will race against each other over 100 meter. Eventually, after three elimination rounds, the three fastest men and women will go through to the final races. There they will determine who takes the win! Between the races the audience will be entertained in a modern and innovative way. There is never a dull moment! For this event the 11Stedenhal in Leeuwarden will be transformed into a real sports theatre with lights, sound and visual effects.

Regulations

The competition will be held under the ISU rules and conditions included in this announcement.

Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the Organising Committee assumes no responsibility with respect to medical, bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage sustained or caused in connection with this competition. Each member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Track

A standard indoor speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at the 11Stedenhal, an artificially frozen indoor skating rink in Leeuwarden, in accordance with ISU Rule 203 and Rule 227.

Participants

There will be 33 male and 33 female participants. Spots are filled as follows:

The Organising Committee has the right to change the number of participants per category.

Selection criteria

Participants are divided in five categories.

Cat 1. International participants

International participants can enter the competition if they meet the time limits for De Zilveren Bal. Limits for participation for international participants are: 10.20 (male) and 11.10 (female). This can be a 100 meter race, or opening during the 500 meter. The time must be skated during the 2022-2023 season.

Cat 2. Dutch participants group 1

Based on the 100 meter VANTAGE list - Dutch times - (until January 1st 2023) and on the 100 meter opening times of the 500 meter during the World Cup Qualification Tournament and National Allround and Sprint Championships. Entry opens on January 4th 2023 at 12:00 and closes on March 1st 2023 at 23:59.

Cat 3. Dutch participants group 2

Based on the 100 meter VANTAGE list - Dutch times - (until February 12th 2023) and on the 100 meter opening times of the 500 meter during the World Cup Qualification Tournament, National Allround and Sprint Championships and National Single Distance Championship. Entry opens on February 15th 2023 at 12:00 and closes on March 1st 2023 at 23:59.

Cat 4. Wild cards

Wild cards are given by the organisation.

Cat 5. Reserve

Selection criteria are equal to category 3. Entry opens on February 15th 2023 at 12:00 and closes on March 1st 2023 at 23:59.

Entries

All Dutch participants will be invited by the Dutch federation (KNSB). Dutch participants can confirm or decline their invitation on www.inschrijven.schaatsen.nl.

International participants can only be registered by the ISU Member who represents them. This can be done by email to info@dezilverenbal.nl with their name, country, age and fastest season 100 meter time. The first 12 registrations per category will be accepted. Entry opens on December 8th 2022 at 12:00 and closes on February 14th 2023 at 23:59.

Entrance fees

There are no entrance fees for competing in De Zilveren Bal.

Races

Three competitors skate in every race. The warming up lane will also be used as a race lane. There will be four rounds. After each round skaters will be eliminated. Eventually, three skaters will make it to the fourth and final round. The form of this competition is in accordance with ISU Rule 253, paragraph 4.a.

Elimination procedure

After each round some skaters will be eliminated. This goes as follows:

- From round 1 the fastest 21 skaters will make it to round 2.
- From round 2 the fastest 9 skaters will make it to the semi-finals.
- From the semi-finals the fastest 3 skaters will make it to the final.

Timekeeping

Timekeeping will be done in accordance with ISU Rule 247.

Race information and results

Race information will be posted on www.schaatsen.nl and will also be available in the Sportity App. More information about the Sportity app will be available in the information bulletin.

Results of De Zilveren Bal are in accordance with Rule 265, paragraph 1.a.
and will be posted on the website above, in the Sportity App and also on

Accreditations

Participants, staff, officials and media each receive an accreditation. This accreditation gives entry to restricted areas. There is one (1) accreditation for a coach available per team up to three athletes. Teams with more athletes are entitled to two (2) accreditations. Coaches must apply for their accreditation via email to info@dezilverenbal.nl.

Training times

The Elfstedenhal will be open for training for entered competitors on Monday March 6th and Tuesday March 7th, 2023. Training times will be described in the information bulletin.

Prizes

There is prize money for both men and women.

1 st place:	€1000,-
2 nd place:	€500,-
3 rd place:	€250,-

The event will be broadcasted live on an online platform.

Medical assistance

Doctors and paramedics will be present on the day of competition.

Parking

Parking facilities for competitors and visitors are at the parking area directly next to the 11Stedenhal ice rink. Parking is free.

Transport

The Organising Committee will arrange transport for all international participants (not living in the Netherlands) to and from the airport and between the hotel and the ice rink for the competition and other activities.

Hotels

The Organising Committee will arrange accommodation (including meals) for all international participants (not living in the Netherlands) from March 6th until March 9th.
