It is with great pleasure the Swedish Figure Skating Association and Göteborg Figure Skating Federation invite you to the

12th Leon Lurje Trophy

An international competition to be held in memory of Dr Leon Lurje, the former chairman of the ISU Synchronized Skating Technical Committee.

The 12th Leon Lurje Trophy will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, the ISU General Regulations 2018, ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2018, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

1. Invited ISU Members

All the Members of the International Skating Union listed on ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018 are invited to Leon Lurje Trophy 2019.

2. General Regulations

Leon Lurje Trophy 2019 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2016, ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2016, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in Leon Lurje Trophy 2019 is open to all Teams who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 130, paragraph 7) and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided the ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 4. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements according to Rule 109, paragraphs 1 and 2 d) and ISU Communication No. 2030 (or any update of this Communication).

The competition will include the following categories:

Senior

Each participating team must consist of sixteen (16) skaters and may have up to a maximum of four (4) alternates listed on the Team Entry Form (Rule 800, paragraph 2 b) and c).

Junior

Each participating team must consist of sixteen (16) skaters and may have up to a maximum of four (4) alternates listed on the Team Entry Form (Rule 800, paragraph 2 b) and c).

Advanced Novice

Each participating team must consist of sixteen (16) skaters and may have up to a maximum of four (4) alternates listed on the Team Entry Form (Rule 800, paragraph 2 b) and c) and ISU Communication 2184.

Basic Novice B

Each participating team must consist of sixteen (16) skaters and may have up to a maximum of four (4) alternates listed on the Team Entry Form (Rule 800, paragraph 2 b) and c) and ISU Communication 2184.

Basic Novice A

Each participating team must consist of twelve (12) skaters and may have up to a maximum of four (4) alternates listed on the Team Entry Form (Rule 800, paragraph 2 b) and c) and ISU Communication 2184.

3. Technical Data

The competition will take place at the Frölundaborg Ice Rink with an ice surface of 60 meters in length and 30 meters in width. Official practice will take place in the same ice rink. The rink is indoor, heated artificial ice rink. 2nd Ice Rink is located 50 m from the main Arena.

Senior

Short Program: Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds, but may be less.

The General Short Program Elements and requirements are listed in Rule 991, paragraphs 1.a), 2, and 3, Rule 992, paragraphs 1.a), 2.a) and 3.a). The Short Program Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2018/19 are listed in ISU Communication 2152.

Free Skating Duration: 4 minutes +/- 10 seconds

The Well Balanced Program Requirements are listed in Rule 991, paragraphs 1.b), 2 and 4, Rule 992, paragraph 1. b), 2.b) and 3. The Free Skating Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2018/19 are listed in ISU Communication 2152.

The starting order for the free skating will be in reversed order from the result in the short program.

Junior

Short Program: Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds, but may be less.

The General Short Program Elements and requirements are listed in Rule 991, paragraphs 1.a), 2, and 3, Rule 992, paragraphs 1.a), 2.a) and 3.a). The Short Program Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2018/19 are listed in ISU Communication 2152.

Free Skating Duration: 3 minutes, 30 seconds, +/- 10 seconds

The Well Balanced Program Requirements are listed in Rule 991, paragraphs 1.b), 2 and 4, Rule 992, paragraph 1. b), 2.b) and 3. The Free Skating Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2018/19 are listed in ISU Communication 2152.

Each participating team must consist of sixteen (16) skaters and may have up to a maximum of four (4) alternates listed on the Team Entry Form (Rule 800, paragraph 2 b) and c).

The starting order for the free skating will be in reversed order from the result in the short program.

Advanced Novice

Free Skating Duration: 3 minutes +/- 10 seconds

The Free Skating Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2018/19 are listed in ISU Communication 2152.

Basic Novice B

Free Skating Duration: 3 minutes +/- 10 seconds

The Free Skating Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2018/19 are listed in ISU Communication 2152 and 2184.

Basic Novice A

Free Skating Duration: 3 minutes +/- 10 seconds

The Free Skating Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2018/19 are listed in ISU Communication 2152 and 2184.

4. Entries

With the entry forms the team shall attach the Planned Program Content Sheet, which must be signed by either the Coach or the Team Leader. The Planned Program Content Sheet may be changed at the time of the registration to the competition.

6. Judges

Each participating ISU Member may enter one (1) judge listed on the ISU list for Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating. Two (2) judges may be entered if the member is participating with at least 4 teams in different categories.

According to ISU Rules the panel of officials for each category will include:

- 1 Technical Controller
- 2 Technical Specialists
- 1 Referee
- Minimum of 5 Judges
- Assistants to the Panel (1 Assistant Referee Ice, 1 Data Operator, 1 Replay Operator).

The first Judges meeting will be held **Friday January 25 at 19h00** at the Official Hotel.

The Organizing Committee will pay for travel expenses for the invited Referee, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay operators only. Travel expenses for Judges are to be paid by each ISU Member.

The Organizing Committee will provide ground transportation, accommodation and meals, from lunch on Friday, January 25th, 2019 to breakfast on Monday, January 28th, 2019 for the invited Referee, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data/Replay Operators and nominated judges.

7. Registration

All Event Officials, Judges, Members of the Official Team Delegation taking part in the Leon Lurje Trophy are requested to register for the competition at the arena on Thursday, January 24 at 17:00-20:00 or Friday 25 at 09:00-16:00.

The Team Leaders/Managers are requested to bring copies of passports of all the skaters (a Team-folder, sorted in the alphabetical order) and present all the passports at the time of registration.

9. Music

Rule 705 § 1 and Rule 724 shall apply. Upon registration Team Leader or Team Manager must present digital copies on USB or two (2) quality copies of their music on CD.

The music must be submitted by the Team Leader at the time of Registration.

All music must be properly inserted in their original cases and must be clearly identified with the name of the Team and must show the exact running time of the music (no skating time), which shall be certified by the Team Leader or Team Manager when submitted at the time of registration.

The titles, composers and orchestra of the Music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must be listed for each Team on the Official Music-, Press-Media Form and attached to the Official Entry Form for Teams.

10. Liability

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each member participating in the Leon Lurje Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for the athletes, Officials and all other members of the Member's Team(s). Such insurance must provide full medical coverage and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The ISU, the Swedish Figure Skating Association and the Organizing Committee for the Leon Lurje Trophy assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the event by Competitors and Officials.

The Organizer will not provide participant insurance coverage for the event.

The Organizer will provide emergency medical services for all Competitors during the competition and official practices at the Official arena. The local hospital is in 10 minutes distance from the Ice Rink.

11. Draws

The Official draws for the competition will take place **Friday January 25 at 20h00** at the Official Hotel. Team Captains, Team Leaders, Coaches and Team Officials are invited to participate at the official draw.

12. Opening ceremony

The opening ceremony will take place **Saturday January 26 at 15h30** in the Arena. Two skaters from each team are asked to take part in the Opening ceremony.

13. Award Ceremony

The Award Ceremony for Advanced Novice will take place immediately after the competition on Saturday and for all other categories immediately after the competition on Sunday.

All medal winning teams in all categories are asked to enter the ice during the ceremony.
