All the Members of the International Skating Union listed on ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018 are invited to enter Teams at Spring Cup 2019.

## **GENERAL RULES**

Spring Cup 2019 is an International Synchronized Ice Skating Competition and will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations 2018 and Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2018 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications (2018-2019).

The teams must belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 7), the ages must fall within the limits specified in Rule 108.

All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102 and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109.

## **CATEGORIES**

The following Categories are included:

**ISU Senior:** Short Program and Free Skating Program **ISU Junior:** Short Program and Free Skating Program

**ISU Advanced Novice:** Free Skating Program

The final results will be determined according to Rules 738-741 and the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating.

#### **ENTRIES AND NOMINATION/REGISTRATION**

Each participating ISU Member can entry up three (3) teams per category.

Each ISU Member may enter three (3) teams per category. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of entries per Member.

**Entries of Teams, nominated Judges, Team Leaders and Team Managers** must be made only by the respective ISU Members on the enclosed Official Forms and must reach the Organizing Committee

not later than December 15th, 2018. Late entries will not be accepted.

**Deadline for Preliminary Entry Form:** November, 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

♦ Each invited ISU Member, sending at least one (1) Team participating in the competition, may nominate only one (1) Judge listed on the ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2018-2019.

♦ The host ISU Member may nominate a **second Judge** listed in the ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2018-2019.

The **Referees** will be invited by the Organizing Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2018-2019.

The **Technical Controllers** will be invited by the Organizing Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Technical Controllers for Synchronized Skating 2018-2019.

The **Technical Specialists** will be invited by the Organizing Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Technical Specialists for Synchronized Skating 2018-2019.

The **Data/Replay Operators** will be invited by the Organizing Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Data/Video Operators 2018-2019.

The Organizing Committee will pay travel expenses at APEX airfare economy rates for the invited Referees, Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists and the Data/Replay Operators only and will provide ground transportation, accommodation and meals, from February 15th lunch to February 18th breakfast for the invited Referees/Technical Controllers/Technical Specialists/Data-Replay Operators and nominated Judges.

Please note: wives, husbands, relatives, physician staff and doctors are not included.

The rooms at GRAND HOTEL BARONE DI SASSJ in Sesto San Giovanni for invited Referees/Technical Controllers/Technical Specialists/Data-Replay Operators and nominated Judges will be reserved by the Organizing Committee upon receipt of the entries.

The **Technical Panel Review Meeting** for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice (Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators) will be held on Sunday February 17th 2019 at 22:00 at the ICE RINK (Technical Panel Room)

The **Round Table Discussion** for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice events will be held on Sunday, February 17th 2019 at 23:00 in GRAND HOTEL BARONE DI SASSJ – Sesto San Giovanni

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#### **TECHNICAL RULES**

ISU Rules shall be in effect according to ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018 and ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2018, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

The following has to be noted: each participating Team may enter up to a maximum of **four (4)** alternates on the official Entry Form; Teams of a Member may enter more than one category using different music and different programs, with a minimum change of 50% of the skaters.

Only those skaters whose names are listed on the registration forms will be allowed to skate.

Age requirements: Rule 108, 4 ISU General Regulations.

a) **Senior Teams:** shall consist of sixteen (16) skaters; all of them must have reached at least the age of 15 before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2018.

Short Program	Maximum 2 min. 50 sec.	Program Component Factor: 0.8
Free Skating Program	4 min. ± 10 sec.	Program Component Factor: 1.6

The prescribed elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Synchronized Skating and pertinent ISU Communications.

b) **Junior Teams:** shall consist of sixteen (16) skaters; all of them must have reached at least the age of 13 but not have reached the age of 19 before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2018.

Short Program	Maximum 2 min. 50 sec.	Program Component Factor: 0.8
Free Skating Program	3 min. 30 sec.	Program Component Factor: 1.6

The prescribed elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Synchronized Skating and pertinent ISU Communications.

c) **Advance Novice Teams:** shall consist of sixteen (16) skaters; all of them must have reached at least the age of 10 but not have reached the age of 15 before July  $1^{st}$  2018.

Free Skating Program	$3 \min \pm 10 sec.$	Program Component Factor: 1.2
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The prescribed elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Synchronized Skating and pertinent ISU Communications.

## **PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT SHEETS**

Along with entries, Teams should attach Planned Program Content Sheets (**Form 8 and 9**), one for the Short Program and one for the Free Skating Program. Planned Program Content Sheets must be signed by a Coach or Team Representative. However programs content may be changed at Competition time.

Form 8 and 9 deadline is January 10th, 2019.

## **MUSIC**

Upon accreditation, in accordance with Rule 724, all Teams shall furnish their competition music of excellent quality on CD (Compact disc) format. Two (2) copies for each program (Short/Free) must be submitted by the Team Leader/Manager at the time of registration. Each one CD must be properly inserted in its original case, must clearly show the name of the Team, the category (Senior/Junior/Advanced Novice), the type of program (Short/Free) as well as the exact running time of the music (not skating time), which shall be certified by Team Leader/Manager when submitted at the time of registration.

Each program (Short/Free) must be recorded on one track and on a separate C.D. (Form 4).

**Preferably** the .mp3 files of the music can be uploaded in advance on **Spring Cup 2019 Music Box.** The link to connect to the folder will be indicated to the participating teams.

(**Note**: this does not exclude files on CD)

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#### **CITIZENSHIP / RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS**

In accordance with ISU Rule 109, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must have a release letter from their national federation.

#### **OFFICIAL ICE RINK**

**PALASESTO ARENA** is located in Sesto San Giovanni (Milan), near the Subway Station, Rail Station and Bus Station and is easily reachable (approx. time):

- 20 minutes' drive from Linate Airport (LIN)
- 60 minutes' drive from Malpensa Airport (MXP)
- 45 minutes' drive from Orio al Serio (Bergamo) Airport (BGY)
- 20 minutes' drive from the Milan Railway Central Station
- 5 minutes' drive from Grand Hotel Barone di Sassi
- 10 minutes' drive from Grand Hotel Duca di Mantova
- 15 minutes' walk from Hotel St. John
- Less than 5 minute walk from the Subway Station, Rail Station and Bus Station.

**Palasesto Arena** has a seating capacity of 3.100. Ice surface is artificial. Size: 30x56 m. During the Competition the Arena will be warmed up.

## **UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE**

Unofficial Practice Ice for all Teams will take place from Wednesday 13th to Friday 15th (see **Form 6**). A minimum of one block (15 min) of Unofficial Practice Ice will be assured to all Teams in Palasesto Arena, in order to let each participating Team practice ice at the main ice rink. Any further reservation requested by Teams will be allocated either in Palasesto Arena or in alternative rink according on availability, and will be arranged on **"first come, first served"** basis.

Please note that confirmation of bookings will only be available after January 10<sup>th,</sup> 2019. The payment of confirmed extra ice will be made not later than January 10<sup>th,</sup> 2019.

Please note that any bus transfer to/from the Unofficial Practice sites will be at Team expenses, to be arranged and paid directly to the bus company.

No extra ice practice will be available after the beginning of the OFFICIAL DRAW.

#### **OFFICIAL PRACTICE**

Each Team will be allowed a 10 minute period of Official Practice ice for Short Program and a 12 minutes period for Free Skating Program, free of charge.

#### **OFFICIAL DRAW**

The Official Draw will take place on Friday, February 15th at 18:30 in GRAND HOTEL BARONE DI SASSJ-Sesto San Giovanni.

Five (5) skaters for each Team are requested to take part in the event.

The Starting Order of the Free Skating will follow the reverse order of places in the Short program, according to the Rule 963 par. 2f.

## **OPENING CEREMONY**

Opening Ceremony will take place at Palasesto Arena on Saturday, February 16th , 30 minutes before the beginning of the Competition.



#### **MEDAL AND TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded to the top three Teams of each category. Medals will be awarded to all skaters.

#### LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, Federazione Italiana Sport Ghiaccio and Organizing Committee of Spring Cup 2019 assumes no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors or Officials in connection with the 2019 Spring Cup International Synchronized Skating Competition.

Each Member participating in the ISU Events has the sole responsibility for providing its own medical and accident insurance protection.

The Organizing Committee will provide emergency medical services for all Competitors at the Competition and at the Official Practice sites.

#### **MEDICAL INFORMATION**

Each Team Manager should be able to give important medical information for each skater for use in case of an emergency or accident.

## **DOPING CONTROL**

Anti-doping tests may be carried out during the competition in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Code (ISU Communications No. 1603-1604).

#### **PASS**

Each participating team will be provided with 5 (five) free passes for: Team Manager, Coach, Assistant Coach, Medical Person, Team Service Personnel.

One more pass <u>for country</u> is reserved for the Team Leader nominated by the participating Federation ISU Member.
