## THE AREA – THE CITY

Salzburg is unique – in every regard. Anyone who has ever immersed themselves in the magic of the world-famous City of Mozart can never escape it again. The harmonious interplay of landscape and architecture, art and culture, as well as tradition and modernity, all within a surprisingly small area, merely adds to the special charm of this place.

Salzburg is the city where Wolfgang A. Mozart was born and the shooting location for “The Sound of Music”. The narrow lanes and broad squares of this baroque city have taken their deserved place on the UNESCO World Heritage List. The internationally acclaimed Salzburg Festival, the magnificent panorama and the countless temptations of Christmastime make Salzburg a complete artwork in its own right, and one that is quite beyond compare.

At one of the numerous museums, shops, traditional businesses or restaurants in the heart of the historical district, every visitor is certain to find his or her favorite Salzburg spot. Often pleasantly tucked away from the bustling city, countless outdoor “guest gardens” invite you to enjoy a refreshing beer accompanied by traditional dishes. Also as a venue for trade shows, the City of Mozart has earned an international reputation.

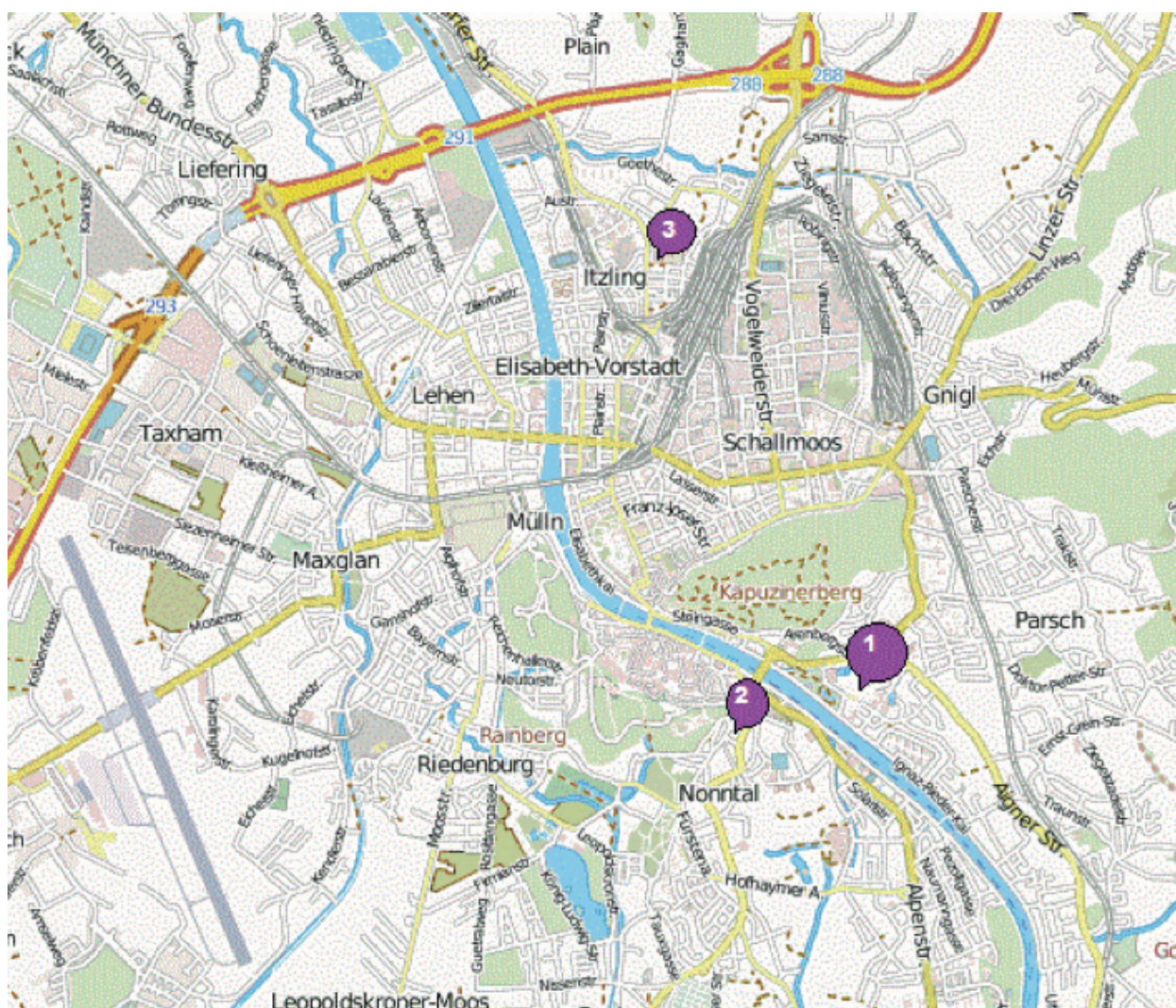
Short distances are a big advantage of the city: from the ice rink to the old town it’s just five minutes!

## THE VENUE

Eisarena Salzburg, Hermann-Bahr-Promenade 2, 5020 Salzburg

Eisarena Salzburg is an indoor sporting arena located in the Volksgarten, very close to the city center of Salzburg. It is home to the Red Bulls Ice Hockey Team and has a capacity of 3.200 people. It has hosted seven ISU Mozartcup Synchronized Skating Competitions.

The competition venue, with an ice surface of 30 X 60 meters, is both indoor and heated.

## TRANSPORT

The „W.A. Mozart“ Salzburg Airport lies about 8 kilometers (4.2 mi) northwest of the city center. Direct flights include Frankfurt, Berlin and Vienna with additional seasonal routes added during the summer and winter months.

The city also has a Hauptbahnhof (central station) on Austria's main rail axis, the West railway, linking Vienna with western Austria, Germany and Switzerland.

Salzburg is connected with Vienna and Munich via the A1/A8 Autobahn/motorway; with the Tauernautobahn A10 Autobahn to the south.

The OC will provide transportation from the airport and station to the Hotels and the ice rink.

## CLIMATE and WEATHER

The warmest time for a visit Salzburg are the months from May to September, when the average maximum temperatures vary between 18°C and 23°C, with average maximum of 23°C between July and August. The average minimum temperatures between May and September range between 8°C to 13°C. But Salzburg is worth a visit in every month of the year!

### Currency

The Austrian currency unit is Euro (EUR) divided in 100 cents.

### Electricity

The electricity current in Austria is 230 Volt. A two-pin plug system is used.

### Banks

Banks are opened Monday to Friday from about 8:30 – 12:30 and 14:30 – 16:00. Cash counters are at nearly every bank and on public places, open 24/7.

## VISA

Austria is part of the Schengen Area, which agreed on the abolition of border controls between themselves and on common visa regulations. By applying for an austrian Visa, a foreigner applies for so-called Schengen Visa which allows him/her to travel inside of the Schengen Area without any restrictions. Schengen Visa holders do not need additional special visa for Austria. 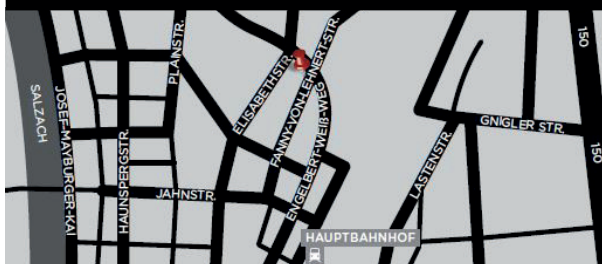

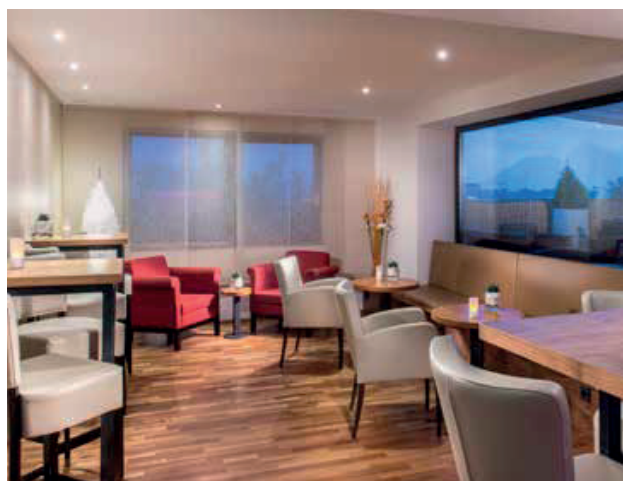
