### TRACK

Arena Ritten \* Collalbo is an outdoor standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap. The width of each lane is 4 meters with an inside training lane with width of 4 meters. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 26 and 30 meters respectively.

### ENTRIES

Entries must be made according to ISU Communication No. 1518 and ISU General Regulations, Rule 115

Preliminary entries, giving the number of competitors and substitutes and team officials (with provisional names) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee by December 15, 2008

Final entries, must be communicated to the Organizing Committee by letter or fax not later than January 05, 2009 (see ISU Communication No. 1518)

The completed Declaration Form must be signed by the competitors and also by all officials (including team officials) appointed the Member serving at an ISU Event (Team Leader, Coaches, Team Medical, Doctors, Physiotherapists, Team Officials who are requesting accreditation for the Event.)

In case of competitors who are not full of age (under 18) the Declaration must be co-signed by at Least one of the parents or other guardian at law.

Each Entry Form and Declaration Form must be signed by an authorized ISU Member Representative such as President, General Secretary, Executive Director (Rule 104).

For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communications Nos. 1517 and 1523 (or any update of these Communications).

### ENTRY QUOTAS

An ISU Member may enter a maximum of 10 competitors per category (10 ladies and 10 men) for an ISU Junior World Cup Competition.

Subject of the qualifying times listed below, maximum 5 competitors may be entered for each individual event.

### QUALIFYING TIMES

Entered skater (including substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances:

JUNIOR LADIES:	500 m	46.00
	1000 m	1.32.00
	1500 m	2.25.00
	3000 m	5.10.00

JUNIOR MEN:	500 m	41.50
	1000 m	1.24.00
	1500 m	2.10.00
	3000 m	4.40.00

For a result to be a valid qualifying time, it must have been achieved in the period between July 01, 2007 and the entry deadline indicated in the paragraph "Entries" above.

### GROUPING AND DRAWING

For each individual distance all entered skaters compete together (in the same division). The entered skaters shall be paired according to their individual Junior World Cup rank, with the two highest ranked skaters starting in the last pair. Skaters from the same country (ISU Member) should not compete in the same pair (see ISU Communication No. 1518, paragraphs 6.3).

### PRIZES POINTS SYSTEM

For each distance Junior World Cup points will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 1518, paragraph 7.2.

### ANTI DOPING

Anti-doping tests may be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Code as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communication No. 1447, 1448 & 1520 or later updates)

### BOARD AND LOGING

The Organizer will bear costs for board and lodging for 3 days, from January 16, 2009 beginning with dinner, until January 19, 2009 ending with breakfast, for 2 skaters and 1 team leader or coach from each Member, in accordance with ISU Communication No. 1518, paragraph 10 f). Additional expenses for rooms and meals will have to be borne by the respective Member.

#### CITIZENSHIP/RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS AND CLEARANCE COMPETITIONS

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 1420 (or any further update of this Communication) all skaters who, do not have the nationality of the Member by wich they have been entered of who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

#### TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered competitors from January, 13 2009 from 9.00 – 12.00 am / 3.00 – 6.00 pm. Trial starts will take place on Friday January 16 from 3.00 pm to 3.45 pm Only accredited persons will be allowed to enter the Ice Rink during the official training hours.

#### LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, the ISU and the organizer assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damages incurred in connection with the ISU Junior World Cup Speed Skating. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

#### TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the international Airports (VERONA /ITALY or INNSBRUCK/AUSTRIA or BOLZANO/ITALY) or from the Railway Station Bolzano to Collalbo and back.

There will also be a transportation service between the Hotel and the Ice Rink.

The date, airline and flight number, expected time of arrival and the date and time departure must be sent to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but not later than January 13, 2009.
