# Introduction of Jeonju City

Jeonju city is located in east longitude 127°, north latitude 35°.

Home to 622,180 residents in 192,960 households, Jeonju city is 206.24 km<sup>3</sup> wide, with a yearly average temperature of 12.9℃, and an annual rainfall of 1296.2mm.

Jeonju is well known with Korean traditional cuisine. One of the most famous Korean food internationally, "Bibimbop" (various vegetables and beef mixed with rice), is originated from this city. They also put efforts to keep Korean traditional culture continuously. More attractions in this city are introduced on the later pages.



# **Transportation**

Arrival & Departure transportation from Incheon airport to Jeonju City



All participants will arrive at Seoul Incheon International Airport and can find the Information Desk with the sign of 2010 ISU Four Continents Figure Skating Championships, Jeonju, Korea, in front of the arrival gates at the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the airport. The OC Staffs of Transportation Team will meet you and arrange the transportation for you or your team. Chaperones and Media may be asked to pay for the shuttle bus service from Incheon Airport to Jeonju.

The OC will provide the transportation from the airport to the official hotels. It will take approximately 4 hours from the airport to Jeonju City. (about 270km)

There may be a waiting period in departure to Jeonju in order to efficiently coordinate transportation need.

During the bus travel from the airport to Jeonju, there will be 15 minutes stop at the service area with convenient store, light snack bar and restroom on the highway and please be careful not to miss the bus.





### **Event Shuttle**

The shuttle bus service will be provided by the OC between the official hotels and the ice rink. The shuttle will run on a 30 min interval from the official hotels to the ice rink. The first bus will reach the ice rink at least 1 hour before the start of the first practice session. There will be 2 lines of the shuttle bus as follows:

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Line No. 1: Riviera Hotel → Core Hote → Ice Rink → Core Hotel → Riviera Hotel
(from Riviera Hotel to Ice rink, it will take about 30 min)
Line No. 2: Jeonju Tourist Hotel → Ice Rink → Jeonju Tourist Hotel

### **Weather Condition**

Korea has four seasons, with a wet monsoon/summer in the middle of the year, and a cold winter from November to March.

Winter in Jeonju lasts from December to mid-March. It can be bitterly cold and snowy during this time due to the influx of cold Siberian air. Heavy snow in the northern and eastern parts of Korea makes for favorable skiing conditions.

### **BANKING & ATM**

Cards with the Plus and Cirrus logos are the easiest to use and most widely accepted in Korea. Some places even accept international cards like China UnionPay, Maestro, Electron, and JCB cards.

Banks as well as other sites have ATMs (automatic teller machines), where customers can make withdrawals, deposits, and fund transfers. However, as all ATM transactions require an account with a Korean bank, ATMs are not particularly convenient for international travelers except for getting cash advances on a credit card.

If you have an account with Citibank, however, you can enjoy a more extensive range of banking services.

Just visit a Citibank location nearby for ATM or counter services. Some ATM/CD machines operate 24 hours a day, while others are open from 8 a.m. to 12 a.m.

# **Attractions of Jeonju City**

### Jeonju Hanokmaeul



Jeonju traditional Korean-style village is representing Korea's traditional culture. Jeonju traditional Korean-style village is the landmark of millennium Jeonju's that most Korean style culture can be found. The clock of history goes counterclockwise once in Jeonju traditional Korean village. It's so antiquated to the extent that one can feel confused with what age they are in. Jeonju traditional Korean village that about 700 houses of traditional Korean-style houses are grouped together is the only city traditional Korean-style gathering in nationwide, which is the largest size traditional Korean-style village located in Pungnab-dong area in Jeonju city. With important cultural assets and facilities including Keonggi hall, Omokdae, Hyanggyo scattered, Jeonju traditional Korean-style village is such an only unique cultural space in Jeonju. That's the very Jeonju traditional Korean-style village where you can feel the beauty and idyllic elegance of old time's classical scholars of virtue.

### In the view of value

Historical point city traditional Korean-style houses around Pungnab district are important data of our country's process residential culture development which evolved in the proceeding course into industrial society from 1920s. It is in particular vary high value as a space of general traditional Korean-style residing place in which one can look into the change in quality by modern Japanese imperialism, transformation into modern traditional Korean-style houses after Liberation on the basis of architectural style and historicity before 19 century's Lee dynasty like Keonggi hall, Confucian temple and school, Hakindang.

### Relics

Pungnab gate and Kyeonggi hall in which the portrait of the first king of Lee dynasty, Lee Seonggae is in, Hanbeokdang, one of 8 scenery of Jeonju, Euimok, Omok stone monument where the first king Lee's greatgreat-grandfather was living, Jeonju Confucian temple and school, Hakindang are scattered to fully enjoy breathing of our traditional culture.

### **Tourist attraction**

Taste and experience of walking are around traditional Korean-style village which is the first place of touring Jeonju culture. Walking in the alleys where about 700 traditional houses are clustered together, unsophisticated scenes like eaves of roof and jar stands over the low fences muster nostalgia. Representing tourist attractions that Jeonju traditional Korean-style village is proud of are Jeonju traditional culture center that can watch and experience traditional culture performance like Pansori, dance, traditional wedding ceremony, Jeonju traditional Korean-style village's living experience hall which can experience Korean-style housing directly like ondol and main floored hall, and Jeonju craftworks exhibition hall that displays traditional objects of craftworks.





### Korean-style village of comfortable rest and smell of tea

Traditional tea house of Korean style village of comfortable rest and smell of tea - In Jeonju people can drink traditional tea which represents Korea. Let's take it easy of tiredness of traveling in here. Being worthy of traditional culture city, traditional tea house located in Jeonju Korean-style village is fully situated in that village of most Korean-style houses. Recently, in Hakindang also 'Seondawon', traditional tea house opens. The name of the tea house is pretty and resembles of Korean-style village and tea. Let's go check it out the taste of tea and atmosphere.
