Decision of ISU Disciplinary Commission

Following consideration of an alleged Anti-Doping Rule violation the ISU Disciplinary Commission has taken the following decision:

- 1. Anzhelika Anatolyenva Gavrilova (KAZ) is declared responsible for an Anti-Doping violation, committed on June 25, 2005.
- 2. A one year ineligibility, beginning December 27, 2005 is imposed on Anzhelika Anatolyenva Gavrilova.
- 3. The Skating Federation of the Republic of Kazakhstan has to pay the ISU the amount of CHF 550.--.
- 4. Each party bears its own costs.

Ms. Gavrilova has indicated her intention to appeal against the decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission to the ISU Appeals Commission. However, as per Article 21, paragraph 16 of the ISU Constitution, an appeal shall have no postponing effect on a sanction for violation of the Anti-Doping rules. It is therefore confirmed that the one year ineligibility period is effective as of December 27, 2005.
