Decision of ISU Disciplinary Commission

On April 6, 2022, the ISU Single & Pair Technical Committee (S&PTC) and Mr. Charles Z. Cyr, ISU Sports Director Figure Skating filed a complaint against Mr. Akos Pethes, the Alleged Offender, for a violation of the Duties of Judges and the ISU Code of Ethics.

Following consideration of the alleged violation of the Duties of Judges and the ISU Code of Ethics, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on May 25, 2022 taken the following decision:

Decision

- 1. The Complaint is dismissed.
- 2. The parties bear their own costs.

The decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission is published in full on the ISU website.

The present decision is subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport, Avenue de Beaumont 2, CH-1012 Lausanne, Switzerland, within 21 days upon receipt of the decision, in accordance with Article 25 Paragraph 12 and Article 26 of the ISU Constitution 2021.
