Decisions of the Council

The ISU Council met on April 22, 2021 via an online meeting. The following were among the decisions taken by the Council during the meeting.

1. Update ISU internal meeting/travel restrictions

Given the current Covid-19 pandemic situation, the Council agreed to extend its policy published in ISU Communication No. 2390 Decisions of the Council, April 8, 2021, namely that all meetings, seminars, examinations or similar of ISU internal bodies shall continue to be held on-line or postponed until at least June 30, 2021.

2. Frankfurt Officials Seminar 2021

The Council decided that in view of the current Covid-19 developments in Germany, the Frankfurt Officials Seminar scheduled for July 4-11, 2021 shall be postponed. If possible the Seminar will instead take place on August 22-29, 2021. An evaluation will be done of which parts of the Seminar shall take place in person in Frankfurt, and which shall be carried out online. An update of ISU Communication No. 2377 Frankfurt Seminar will be published in due course.

3. Synchronized Skating Elite 12 - Teams with 12 Skaters

The Council decided that following the positive response from ISU Members to ISU Communication No. 2378, the Elite 12 concept of Synchronized Skating Teams of 12 Skaters shall be tested at two International Competitions during the 2021/22 season. Further information will be provided in due course about the concerned International Competitions and Program requirements.

4. ISU Council meetings

The next online Council meeting is scheduled for June 3, 2021.
