# ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating 2022/23 Media Accreditation

The ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating Series will start on August 24, 2022. The Series is comprised of seven events plus the <u>ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating Fina</u>I, which will be held December 8 – 11, 2022 in Torino (ITA).

#### COVID-19 Measures

In an ongoing Covid-19 pandemic context, the health and safety of all participants at ISU Events including the athletes, team members, officials, volunteers, service providers, broadcasters, media, and spectators needs to be given additional attention. The <u>Guidelines for ISU Events during the COVID-19 Pandemic</u> and the <u>Sport Specific Annex – Figure Skating</u> describe the minimum sanitary measures that must be put in place to host an ISU Event during a COVID-19 pandemic situation. If the local health authorities require a stricter policy in order to host the Event, those stricter policies will need to be followed.

<u>General measures</u> (see details in the respective ISU Covid-19 Guidelines):

- Masks are not mandatory but it is highly recommended to wear them inside the official Event locations (Ice Rink, Transportation, Hotel). If the host country/local community/venue has a stricter mask wearing policy, then masks must be worn as per the local authorities' policy.
- Social distance must apply wherever possible.
- A dining room can be used with buffet-style meals if hand sanitizers is available prior to entry to the dining room and near the buffet station.

#### General ISU Covid-19 Testing policy:

- 1. It is highly recommended for every Event attendee to make a Covid-19 test **prior to departure** from Home to the event location.
- 2. **Prior to accreditation**, every Event Attendee (incl. people with a former Covid-19 infection) must take an Antigen (Rapid) Test organized by the OC.

3. **During/End of JGP Event Week**: If an Antigen (Rapid) test shows a positive result or a person shows Covid-19 symptoms, an Antigen and/or PCR Test will be conducted, and the respective person will need to stay isolated until the result is known.

For specific departure tests required for the return home, including a travel certificate, the costs will be borne in the same way as the below-mentioned tests prior to arrival.

#### Cost Coverage Testing policy:

Media/Journalists will be requested to cover the costs for Antigen (Rapid) test upon accreditation themselves.

#### Pre-conditions on attending an ISU Event for all on-site media

In order for any media accreditation application to be considered, the following requirements need to be observed :

- 1. Apply for media accreditation via the relevant Organizing Committee (OC) below.
- 2. Present the necessary documentation as requested by the OC, and which may include sanitary certifications/testing results.
- 3. Respect any sanitary guidelines that may be in place depending on the situation in each country.

The ISU will not be held responsible for any travel restrictions or delays, even if an accreditation request has been approved.
