## Request for Bid Applications ISU Junior World Cup Short Track for Seasons 2024/25 and 2025/26

Following the allotments of the first ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Competitions during the season 2023/24, the ISU is now looking for applications to host Competitions for the seasons 2024/25 and 2025/26.

As announced in ISU Communication No. 2548, the objective of the ISU support for this series is to ensure the proper, consistent organization and conduct of three (3) Junior World Cup Short Track Competitions per season linked together as a new ISU Series giving adequate opportunities for many Junior Skaters to compete at the international junior level and the opportunity for more Officials to officiate at an international level.

Participation will be open to Skaters of the Junior A & B categories with a maximum number of 5 Skaters per gender, per ISU Member.

The ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Series is planned with the following season calendar:

- In the early part of the season: 2 Events to be held in Europe on consecutive weekends, preferably in the same location or in close proximity one to the other.
- The third Event to be held the weekend before the World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships, either in the same venue or in another close-by location in the Host country of the World Junior Championships.

For the below 2 seasons, the ISU has identified the following preferred dates for the 3 ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Competitions:

Hosting Members of the World Junior Championships 2025 and 2026 are expected to submit an application for hosting Junior World Cup 3 in the respective season.
