Decision of ISU Disciplinary Commission

The ISU filed with the ISU Disciplinary Commission a Complaint against Yuri Larionov, a Figure Skater from Russia, for an alleged Anti-Doping Rule violation.

Following consideration of the alleged Anti-Doping Rule violation, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on April 6, 2008, taken the following decision:

- 1. Yuri Larionov is declared responsible for an Anti-Doping violation, committed on November 26, 2007
- 2. A two years' ineligibility, beginning on January 18, 2008 is imposed on Yuri Larionov.
- 3. The Figure Skating Federation of Russia has to pay the ISU the amount of:
 - US\$ 1'401.--
 - Euro 410.--
 - CHF 650.--
- 4. Each party bears its own costs.

The present decision is subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport, Av. de Beaumont 2, CH-1012 Lausanne, Switzerland, within 21 days upon receipt of the decision, in accordance with Article 23.12 and Article 24 of the ISU Constitution.
